(Cap 43:07)

CONTROL OF GOODS, PRICES, AND OTHER CHARGES (PETROLEUM PRICES) REGULATIONS, 1997
(Published on 29th April, 1997)

ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

1. Citation
2. Interpretation
3. Retail prices of petroleum products
4. Revocation of S.I. 85 of 1996

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on him by section 3 of the Control of Goods, Prices and Other Charges Act, the Minister of Commerce and Industry hereby makes the following Regulations —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Goods, Prices and Other Charges (Petroleum Prices) Regulations, 1997, and shall come into operation on 1st May, 1997.

Citation and
commence-
ment

2. In these Regulations "levy" has the same meaning as in the Control of Goods (Petroleum Products)(Levy) Regulations.

Interpretation

3. No person shall sell by retail, either in person or through an agent or employee —

Retail prices
of petroleum
products

(a) at any place specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto, the petroleum products specified at the head of the second, third, fourth or fifth column of the said Schedule, at a price exceeding the amount per litre specified in relation to that place in that column, which amount shall include —

(i) in respect of petrol, levies of 0,5 and 8 thebe per litre respectively, payable in respect of the National Petroleum Fund and the Motor Vehicle Insurance Fund, and a levy of 3 thebe per litre in respect of the Road Fund;

(ii) in respect of diesel, levies of 0,3 and 8 thebe per litre respectively, payable in respect of the National Petroleum Fund and the Motor Vehicle Insurance Fund, and a levy of 3 thebe per litre in respect of the Road Fund;

(b) at any place specified in the first column of the said Schedule, illuminating paraffin for domestic use, in quantities of a litre or less, at a price not proportionate to that specified in relation to that place in the third column of the Schedule; or

(c) at any place not specified in the first column of the said Schedule, the petroleum product at the head of the —

- (i) second column of the Schedule at a price exceeding by more than 12 thebe per litre;
 - (ii) third column of the Schedule at a price exceeding by more than 11 thebe per litre;
 - (iii) fourth column of the Schedule at a price exceeding by more than 11.7 thebe per litre;
 - (iv) fifth column of the Schedule at a price exceeding by more than 12 thebe per litre,
- the price at which the product was delivered to him.

Revocation of
S.I. 85 of 1996

4. The Control of Goods, Prices and Other Charges (Petroleum Prices) Regulations, 1996, are hereby revoked.
