IMMIGRATION (POINTS OF ENTRY) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1998 (Published on 19th March, 1998)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Labour and Home Affairs by section 4 of the Immigration Act, the following Order is hereby made —

1. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Points of Entry) Citation (Amendment) Order, 1998.
