## BIRTHS AND DEATHS REGISTRATION (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1998 (Published on 22nd May, 1998)

## MEMORANDUM

A draft of the above Bill, which it is proposed to present to the National Assembly, is set out below.

The present births and deaths registration system provides for compulsory registration within four urban areas, namely, Lobatse, Gaborone, Selibe-Phikwe and Francistown and within eight villages, namely, Kanye, Molepolole, Mochudi, Serowe, Mahalapye, Maun, Gumare and Kasane. Voluntary registration covers the rest of the areas not mentioned here. There is shortage of manpower to carry out the collection of data even in areas covered by compulsory registration. The data collected is incomplete and is not reliable to be used for planning purposes.

The object of the Bill is to enhance the provisions of the existing births and deaths registration systems in order to ensure the collection and maintenance of an accurate and reliable official data for public record and for planning purposes. In order to facilitate that objective, the Bill proposes to amend the Act so as to provide -

1. in section 3, for the appointment of Registration Officers in addition to the District Registrars;

2. in section 4, for the Still-Birth Register in addition to the Births and Deaths Register;

3. in section 8, for compulsory registration to be applicable through out the country;

4. in section 24, that medical practitioners be required to give notification of the death of a patient under their care to the District Registrar or Registration Officer;

5. for matters incidental to and connected to the foregoing.

## An Act to amend the Births and Deaths Registration Act

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

1. This Act may be cited as the Births and Deaths Registration (Amendment) Act, 1997.

2. Section 2 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act (referred to in this Act as "the Act") is amended by inserting therein, in their correct alphabetical order, the following new definitions —

- "authorised person" means, in relation to births or still-births, a Chief or administrative officer, and in relation to deaths, an administrator of the deceased's estate;
- "next of kin" means a spouse, parent, or child of a person in respect of whom a certificate is issued under the provisions of this Act.

**3.** Section 3 is amended by substituting for subsection (2) thereof, the following new subsection —

"(2) The Minister may appoint —

- (a) such number of District Registrars as the Minister may deem necessary to exercise, subject to the directions of the Registrar, such of the functions of the Registrar, as the Registrar may direct from time to time; and

- (b) accompanied by the prescribed fee:

Provided that no fee shall be payable in the case of an application for late registration if, at the time of birth, still-birth or death, the law made no provision for its registration.

(3) The District Registrar or the Registration Officer shall comply with section 12 in respect of each application for late registration. (4) The Registrar may refuse to register a birth, stillbirth or death under this section until such time as material facts relating to such birth, still-birth or death have been proved to the Registrar's satisfaction.

(5) Any person aggrieved by a refusal of the Registrar in terms of subsection (4) may appeal in the prescribed manner to the Minister, whose decision shall be final."
