INCOME TAX (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1998

(Published on 22nd June, 1998)

MEMORANDUM

A draft of the above Bill, which it is intended to present to the National Assembly, is set out below.

The object of the Bill is to amend the Income Tax Act. Clause 3 deletes the words "and subject to subsection (2)" as section 50 has no subsection 2. Clause 4 removes the application of paragraph 7 of Part V of the Third Schedule from the calculation of the gross income of mining operations. Clause 5 makes provision for deductions of mines to be subject to the provisions of the Twelfth Schedule while clause 6 increases the exceptions to section 50(2). Clause 7 makes provision for the chargeable income of mining operations to be taxed according to the Twelfth Schedule and clause 8 removes the discretion of the Commissioner. Clause 9 reduces the interest on unpaid tax from two percent to one and a half percent and it further removes the discretion of the Commissioner. Clause 10 introduces civil penalties while clauses 11, 12 and 13 introduces the guilt element by using the words "willfully and with intent to evade liability to tax". Clause 14 expands the definition of public companies to collective investment undertakings or unit trusts. Clause 15 expands the taxable income of a participator and the manner of taxing such income while clause 16 provides for preservation of documents in respect of business carried in Botswana and foreign business not registered in Botswana. Clause 17 amends the Second Schedule by increasing classes of gross income that is exempt while clause 18 deletes Part V from the Third Schedule as taxation of mining will now be regulated in accordance with the Twelfth Schedule. Clause 19 increases the grace period from 15 to 31 days while clause 20 amends the Sixth Schedule. Clause 21 gives a time frame within which a certificate of amount of tax deducted has to be issued and increases the number of days within which a return has to be furnished. Clause 22 creates the Twelfth Schedule under which the taxation of mining will be regulated.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

Short title Amendment of section 2 of Act No. 12 of 1995

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Income Tax (Amendment) Act, 1998.
- 2. Section 2 of the Income Tax Act (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), is amended -
 - (a) by inserting in their correct alphabetical order, the following new definitions -
 - (i) "equity' means paid up value of all shares and the amount standing to the credit of the share premium account of a company, the accumulated profits and the asset revaluation reserves of the company at the beginning of the year of assessment, reduced by the sum of any debt obligation owed by the company and accumulated losses at the beginning of the year of assessment"; and
 - (ii) 'debt' means the greatest amount at any time during the year of assessment of any debt obligation owed by the company on which interest is payable and deductible";

- (b) in the definition of the word "company" by substituting for paragraph (c) the following new paragraph -"(c) collective investment undertaking or unit trust; and"; and
- (c) in the definition of the word "dividend" under paragraph (d) (i) of the proviso thereto, by deleting the words "the shares or units of which are accepted for listing on the Botswana Stock Exchange,".
- 3. Section 10 of the Act is amended by deleting the words " and subject to subsection (2)" therefrom.

- (g) furnishes to his employer or Commissioner an incorrect return of personal particulars, or gives incorrect information to his employer in relation to a matter affecting the amount of tax to be deducted from his remuneration;
- (h) issues, possesses, uses or causes to be issued or used any certificate of remuneration and tax deducted which is incorrect;
- (i) fails to deduct any tax from payment made to a non resident to which section 56 applies;
- (j) within the prescribed period, fails to pay to the Commissioner any amount deducted under section 56;
- (k) within the prescribed period fails to notify the Commissioner that he has entered into a contract to which the Sixth Schedule applies; or
- (l) fails to comply with the provisions of section 57; shall be liable to a penalty of P100 per day or 1 percent of the tax due for each month or part of a month that the violation continues, whichever is the greater."

Insertion of Twelfth Schedule to the Act

"TWELFTH SCHEDULE (section 42)

1. In ascertaining the business chargeable income of any person for any tax year from a business of mining, there shall be deducted from his business assessable income an allowance to be known as a mining capital allowance, computed in accordance with 100 percent of the mining capital expenditure made in the year in which such expenditure was incurred with unlimited carry forward of losses.

Mining capital allowance

2. Where separate and distinct mining operations are carried on in mines which are not contiguous, the deduction to be allowed shall be calculated separately and shall not be transferable between such operations, except expenditure on a license or lease which has been relinquished by the mining company.

Separate calculations for different mines

3. Where a mine to which this Part applies is disposed of or the mineral concession in respect thereof is terminated in any tax year, the provisions of paragraphs 2 and 3 of Part V of the Third Schedule shall apply; and the references therein to allowances shall be deemed to relate to the mining capital allowances granted in respect of the mining capital expenditure in relation to that mine.

Balancing allowance and balancing charge

4. Mining profits shall be taxed according to the following formula—
Annual tax rate = 70 - 1500

Mining profits

X

where X is the profitability ratio, given by taxable income as a percentage of gross income.

Provided that the tax rate shall not be less than the company rate (current 25 percent) made up of 15 percent basic company tax rate and 10 percent additional company tax rate.

5. Head office expenses allowed as a deduction in ascertaining gross revenue from mineral license shall be limited to 1.5 percent of gross income for the year of assessment and an excess of such expense above the limit shall be treated and taxed as a dividend.

Head office expenses

6. Where a foreign controlled resident company has a foreign debt-to-equity ratio in excess of 3 to 1 at any time during the year of assessment, the amount of interest paid by the resident company during that year on that part of the debt that exceeds the ratio shall be disallowed as a deduction and an amount so disallowed shall be treated and taxed as a dividend.

Foreign controlled company Foreign based company 7. Where a foreign based company grants a loan to an affiliated company resident in Botswana, at an interest rate which the Commissioner considers to be in excess of the market rate which a borrower dealing at arm's length with a lender would pay for that type and currency of loan, that part of interest payment which exceed the market rate shall be disallowed as a deduction and the amount of interest so disallowed shall be treated and taxed as a dividend.

Royalty payments

8. Royalty payments made by the mining company under the provisions of the Mines and Minerals Act during any year of assessment shall be allowed as a deduction in the computation of the company's chargeable income in the year of assessment.

Withholding taxes

- 9. The rate of withholding taxes shall be-
- (a) 15 percent on each payment of dividend made to a resident;
- (b) 15 percent on each payment of dividend, interest, commercial royalty, management or consultancy fee made to a non resident; and
- (c) 10 percent on each payment of entertainment fee made to a non resident.

Request of documents

- 10. (1) The Commissioner may request the company to furnish such documents as he may require to show that all minerals sold or disposed by the company in any year of assessment have been valued at a fair market price for the purpose of determining the company's income tax liability for the year.
- (2) Where the Commissioner is not satisfied that the minerals were sold at a fair market price, he may make a determination as to the appropriate valuation of the minerals for income tax purposes.

Application

- 11. (1) The provisions of this Schedule shall not be subject to negotiations under section 53 or any other section of the Act and shall not be applicable to diamond mining.
- (2) Any mining company which is subject to the existing mining tax agreement may continue to operate under the terms of such agreement or make a once only election to come under the provisions of this Schedule by written notice to the Commissioner, not later than 30th June 1999.
- (3) Where a company makes an election to be taxed under this Schedule, the provisions of the mining tax agreement shall not be applicable.

Diamond mining 12. Diamond mining shall be taxed under the terms of an agreement entered into under the provisions of section 53 of this Act."
