CONSTRUCTION OF THE MOLEPOLOLE — LEPHEPE ROAD NOTICE OF PRE-QUALIFICATION OF CONTRACTORS

THE Government of the Republic of Botswana, Ministry of Works, Transport and Communications — Roads Department, invites contractors to pre-qualify for the construction of the Molepolole-Lephepe Road, Located in the Kweneng District, Botswana.

The project will comprise construction of approximately 130 kilometres of main road alignment to Botswana Roads Department truck road standard together with approximately 20 kilometres of village access roads to bitumen standard. The project alignment is mainly through Kalahari sands with localised areas of moderately expansive clay soils. Scope of works will include construction of main and access roads including all ancillary works and drainage; provision of engineer's accommodation, offices, laboratories and transportation, extracting and processing borrow materials for use in earthworks and pavement construction, crushing and screening of materials for use as base course and in surfacing; and maintenance of the works for a period of one year. The project will be wholly financed by the Government of the Republic of Botswana.
