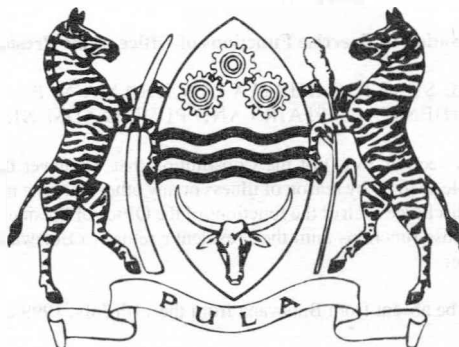

CONSTITUTION OF BOTSWANA

Authorisation to Exercise Functions of Office of the President

TO: THE HONOURABLE SERETSE KHAMA IAN KHAMA M.P., VICE-PRESIDENT AND MINISTER OF PRESIDENTIAL AFFAIRS AND PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 36 (1) of the Constitution that whenever the President is absent from Botswana or considers it desirable so to do by reason of illness or any other cause he may, by directions in writing, authorise the Vice-President to discharge such of the functions of the Office of President as he may specify, and the Vice-President may discharge those functions until the President's return to Botswana or the revocation of such authorisation, as the case may be;

AND WHEREAS I intend to be absent from Botswana from the 11th July, 1999 and I consider it desirable to issue directions as aforesaid;

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested in me as aforesaid I authorise you, SERETSE KHAMA IAN KHAMA, in your capacity as Vice-President and Minister of Presidential Affairs and Public Administration, to discharge with effect from the 11th July, 1999 all the functions of the Office of President, except —

- (a) the power to dissolve Parliament in accordance with the provisions of section 91 of the Constitution;
- (b) the power to appoint to the office of Minister or Assistant Minister in accordance with the provisions of section 42 of the Constitution;
 Provided, however, that you can appoint the present Ministers or Assistant Ministers to act in place of any Minister who is otherwise not available;
- (c) the power to remove a Minister or Assistant Minister from office in accordance with the provisions of section 43 of the Constitution;

until my return to Botswana or this authority is revoked by me whichever happens first.

(e) 1 member representing the Ministry of Commerce and Industry.

(3) Any member, appointed under sub-regulation (2) (a) of this regulation, shall be appointed from the names, kept in the Ministry in terms of regulation 2 (9) (a) of the Tribal Land Regulations, of elected candidates for that subordinate land board area.

(1) At least two months before the election of members, for appointment to any land board, as specified in the third column of the First Schedule to the Act, the Ministry of Local Government, Lands and Housing shall cause to be published in two or more newspapers of national circulation an invitation, to any person residing within the tribal area of that land board, desiring to be elected and appointed as a member of that land board, to submit his application to the secretary of that land board.

(2) In order to qualify as a candidate for election and appointment as a member of any land board the applicant shall —

- (a) be a citizen of Botswana, holding a valid identity card issued under the National Registration Act;
- (b) have attained the age of 21 years and not be over the age of 65 years;
- (c) hold a minimum academic qualification of, or equivalent to, a Secondary School Junior Certificate;
- (d) reside within the tribal area in respect of which he seeks election; and
- (e) not be actively involved in party politics.

Provided that if the tribal area is too large for it to be practicable for all the residents to assemble at the principal *kgotla*, the villages in the tribal area may be divided into groups, with each group of villages electing a proportionate amount (relative to its population in the aggregate population of the groups) of the 20 candidates, the names of whom shall be submitted to the Land Board Selection Committee for that tribal area; and

(b) people residing in an area falling under the jurisdiction of a subordinate land board shall assemble at a *kgotla* and elect 10 candidates residing in the subordinate land board area, and the names of these candidates shall be submitted to the Land Board Selection Committee for that tribal area:

Provided that if the subordinate land board area is too large for it to be practicable for all the residents to assemble at the *kgotla*, the villages in the subordinate land board area may be divided into groups, with each group of villages electing a proportionate amount (relative to its population in the subordinate land board area) of the 10 candidates, the names of whom shall be submitted to the Land Board Selection Committee for that tribal area.

(5) During the election of candidates the Tribal Authority or his representative shall preside, assisted or guided by senior Government officers within the area.

(6) A person shall not be entitled to vote for a candidate to a land board within a tribal area unless he –

- (a) is a citizen of Botswana;
- (b) holds a valid identity card issued under the National Registration Act;
- (c) has attained the age of 18 years; and
- (d) resides within the tribal area of that land board.

(7) At the *kgotla* all the candidates shall first be introduced to the people and thereafter the people shall indicate their vote for a candidate by standing in a queue behind that candidate.

(8) From the lists of candidates submitted, the Land Board Selection Committee shall select the most eligible members, from whom the Minister shall make appointments to the land board (in accordance with the number of members and period of office for that land board, as provided in the third column of the First Schedule to the Act) and in doing so shall endeavour to ensure that, so far as possible, all relevant parts of the tribal area, including subordinate land board areas, are represented on the land board.

(9) The names of the candidates who have been elected but not appointed to the land board by the Minister shall be kept in the Ministry for the purposes of appointing —

(a) under regulation 3(2)(a) of the land board (Subordinate Land Boards) Regulations, members to any subordinate land board within the land board area, from candidates, elected in terms of regulation 4(b) of this regulation, residing within the area of jurisdiction of that subordinate land board;

(b) new members, should the office of any elected member to the land or subordinate land board become vacant; or

(c) in the Minister's discretion, for appointing any other member of the land board or subordinate land board.

(10) In making appointments the qualifications and experience of the candidate shall be taken into consideration.

(11) There is hereby established, for each land board listed in the First Schedule to the Act, a Land Board Selection Committee for the corresponding tribal area, which shall be comprised of —

(a) the appropriate District Commissioner, who shall be the chairperson;

(b) the Land Board Secretary of the tribal area concerned, who shall be the secretary of the Land Board Selection Committee;

(c) the Council Secretary of the District Council concerned;

(d) the Chief or Sub-Chief of the tribal area concerned; and

(e) a member appointed by the Minister.

(12) The Land Board Selection Committee shall determine its own procedure.”.

 - (a) total monthly turnover statistics in pula from the trade and service sector;
 - (b) total quarterly income and expenditure from the financial sector;
 - (c) stock of loans and deposits at the end of each quarter from the financial sector banks;
 - (d) total monthly value of construction work from the construction sector;
 - (e) total number of employees on payroll at the end of each quarter from all the sectors mentioned in paragraphs (a) (b) (c) and (d).
3. (1) The Government Statistician may, for the purposes of these Regulations, serve or cause to be served on any person, questionnaires in Form A, Form B, Form C and Form D set out in the Schedule. Service of questionnaires
 - (2) The questionnaires served in accordance with subregulation (1) shall be accompanied by a Government of Botswana official envelope addressed to the Government Statistician, Central Statistics Office, Private Bag 0024, Gaborone and marked "Statistics".
4. Any person on whom questionnaires are served shall, within 30 days of receipt of such questionnaires, complete, sign and return them to the Government Statistician enclosed in an envelope addressed in the manner set out under regulation 3 (2). Questionnaires to be answered

Penalties

5. Any person who fails or refuses to answer any question put to him for purposes of these Regulations shall be guilty of an offence and shall upon conviction, be liable to a fine of P100 and in the case of a continuing offence, to a fine of P5 for every day during which the offence continues.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Finance and Development Planning by section 15 of the Statistics Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Statistics (Informal Sector Survey) Regulations, 1999. Citation

2. The Government Statistician may direct any authorised officer to conduct a survey on the conditions of Botswana's informal sector in order to collect data that can provide information on the — Authorisation to conduct a survey

- (a) contribution of informal sector to the economy's total output;
- (b) types of major activities in the informal sector;
- (c) proportion of workforce employed in the informal sector;
- (d) proportion of household income generated by the informal sector; and
- (e) size of capital investment in informal sector.

3. The authorised officer may, for the purposes of the survey, ask any person interviewed, such questions as necessary to obtain, of that person, the information required in the questionnaires set out in Form - ISSH, Form - FSS and Form - ISSI of the Schedule. Conduct of survey

4. Any person who fails or refuses to answer any question put to him for purposes of these Regulations shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fine of P100 and in the case of a continuing offence, to a fine of P5 for every day during which the offence continues. Penalties
