The objects of the Bill are, *inter alia*, to provide that fees, to be paid in terms of the Act, be prescribed by the Minister; to repeal the special provisions regarding publication of banns when the intended marriage is between British subjects, one of whom is residing in the United Kingdom; to raise the marriageable age, for both males and females, to eighteen years; to allow for a minor to apply to court, for consent to marriage, where the consent of one parent is given but that of the other parent is refused; to make it an offence for a marriage officer to purport to delegate his function of solemnizing a marriage to a person who has not been appointed a marriage officer; to increase the prescribed fines (having regard to the decreased value of money); and to substitute the stigmatising word "illegitimate" with the relatively neutral words "born out of wedlock".

PRISONS (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1999

MEMORANDUM

A draft of the above Bill, which it is intended to present to the National Assembly, is set out below.

The object of the Bill is to amend the Prisons Act to empower the Minister to create additional ranks for the Prisons Service and, on the certification of a medical officer, release a terminally ill prisoner whose condition of illness is such that prison officers are unable to provide care for or who has been discharged from hospital and recommended for home based care; to empower the courts to order convicted prisoners who have been sentenced to not more than twelve months' imprisonment, to be employed on work carried on outside of the prison under the immediate control and supervision of a public authority; to empower the Commissioner to appoint prison officers up to the rank of Superintendent; to empower the Permanent Secretary, after consultation with the Commissioner, to appoint prison officers from the rank of Senior Superintendent to Deputy Commissioner and, to empower the Commissioner and official visitors to release a prisoner whose remaining period of imprisonment does not exceed twelve months to be employed, with his consent, on public work or service outside the prison under the immediate control and supervision of a public authority, provided that the prisoner is not serving sentence for the offence of rape.

(b) who has been discharged from hospital and recommended for home based care.

(2) 'Release' under subsection (1) means permitting a terminally ill prisoner to leave prison and be placed in the custody of relatives or such local authority or person as may be responsible if relatives cannot be traced, who shall care for the prisoner until his demise or until his recovery, whereupon he shall be required to complete the unexpired term of his sentence.

"Courts may order extra mural labour for offenders 96. Notwithstanding the provisions of this Act or any other law, an offender who has been sentenced to a term of imprisonment not exceeding twelve months (whether that term consists of a single punishment or punishments running concurrently or consecutively) or who has been committed by any court for non-payment of a fine not exceeding P800, may, by order of the court and with the consent of the offender, be employed under the immediate control and supervision of a public authority on public work or service carried on outside prison."
