VACANCY FOR RECEPTIONIST

Title of Post.—Receptionist.

Qualification.—A female Ghanaian between the ages of 30-40 years; should be in possession of at least the Middle School Leaving Certificate or its equivalent, a keen sense of responsibility; should have an interest in people of all walks of life, be able to speak good and fluent English. Proficiency in at least one Ghanaian Language other than the candidate's own will be an advantage.

Duties.—To receive visitors who call at the offices of the National Archives in Accra and to give them the necessary guidance and directions, and to carry out any other duties which may be assigned to her from time to time.

Salary.—N¢636 x N¢24–N¢732 per annum.

Method of Application.—Applications stating age, qualifications, experience of candidate and the names of two referees should be addressed to the Chief Archivist, National Archives, P.O. Box 3056, Accra, to reach his office not later than 16th January, 1971. Copies of two recent testimonials should be enclosed.

MINISTRY OF HEALTH

VACANCIES FOR PUPIL X'RAY OPERATORS

Applications are invited for the award of a scholarship for training leading to appointment in the Ministry of Health as X'Ray Operators Grade II. Selected candidates will be bonded to serve Government for a period of five years after satisfactory completion of the course.

2. *Qualifications:*

- (a) Candidates must be citizens of Ghana.
- (b) They must possess the minimum educational qualification of the West African School Certificate or its equivalent and must have obtained Credit/Pass in a Science subject.
- (c) They must not have attained their 30th birthday.

3. The period of training will be three years in the X'Ray Department of Korle Bu Hospital, or other Government Hospitals to gain practical experience under qualified supervision. During the period of training candidates will receive the following training allowances:—

- (a) West African School Certificate or its equivalent: N¢510 per annum rising by annual increments of N¢30 to N¢570 per annum.
- (b) Attempted but failed West African School Certificate or its equivalent: N¢480 per annum rising by annual increment of N¢30 to N¢540 per annum.

On satisfactory completion of the course, candidates will be required to sit for a departmental examination. Failure to complete the course satisfactorily (which may be extended) and pass the examination at the third attempt will result in the termination of award.

4. Candidates who satisfactorily complete the course, including the passing of the final departmental examination will be considered for appointment on probation to the pensionable grade of X'Ray Operator Grade II, on the salary range 29, 35, 40, i.e. N¢792–N¢1,428 per annum entering the scale at N¢792 per annum point.

5. X'Ray Operators Grade II have the prospects of promotion to the Grade of Radiographer on salary range 45, 50, i.e. (N¢1,488–N¢2,124) and Senior Superintendent Radiographer on salary range 55, 60, i.e. (N¢2,208–N¢3,108). Provision is also made for further promotion to the grade of Chief Radiographer on salary range 65, i.e. N¢3,228–N¢3,720.

(a) PHARMACIST

Duties.—The duties of the successful candidate will include dispensing of drugs to out-patients and in-patients, supply of drugs to various sections of the Hospital. Stock-taking of drugs and equipment in the stores; keeping of accurate records and accounting. Preparation of yearly returns. Purchasing of drugs and hospital equipment and supervision of subordinate staff.

Qualifications.—Candidates must be members of the Pharmaceutical Society of Ghana, or possess an equivalent qualification.

Salary Scale.—N¢1,700 x N¢80–N¢2,180; N¢2,280 per annum.

(b) STAFF NURSE/MIDWIFE

The successful candidate will be responsible for the proper treatment in the wards and out-patients Department, as ordered by the Medical Officers. Emergency treatment, where first-aid is necessary. The candidate will be engaged on midwifery duties and also be required to undertake night duties.

Qualifications.—Candidates must possess the West African School Certificate or the G.C.E. Ordinary Level. Must be S.R.N. and S.C.M.

Candidates without the full qualifications may be considered but at a lower point.

Salary Scales:

- (i) S.R.N. with School Certificate and S.C.M.—N¢1,000 x N¢50–N¢1,500 per annum.
- (ii) S.R.N. with S.C.M. but without School Certificate—N¢950 x N¢50–N¢1,500 per annum.
