#### NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO BE REGISTERED AS A POLITICAL PARTY

(Paragraph 5 (d))

It is hereby notified for general information that the organization known as the Ghana People's Party has on the 6th day of November, 1971 applied to the Registrar to be registered as a Political Party.

Two copies of the constitution or rules of that organization together with a list of all the founding members of that organization and full description of the identifying symbol of that organization have been lodged with the Registrar at the Office of the Electoral Commission situate at the junction of Castle Road and 8th Avenue, Accra.

Any person desirous of raising an objection concerning the name, aims, objects, symbols, constitution or rules of the said organization is hereby invited to raise any such objection to the Registrar of Political Parties.

Upon the expiration of a period of twenty-one days from the date of the publication of this notice the Registrar shall, if satisfied that all the provisions of the Political Parties Decree, 1969 with respect to registration have been complied with and that no valid objection has been raised, proceed to register the said organization as a Political Party.
