PRELIMINARY QUALIFYING EXAMINATION

Notice is hereby given that the Preliminary Qualifying Examination for all Pupil Nurses in training who have completed one or more years' nursing experience in a Training Hospital approved by the Nurses' Board by the 15th December, 1971 and have attended at least seventy-five per cent of the lectures in each subject of the syllabus laid down by the Nurses' Board for the Preliminary Qualifying Examination will take place on 11th, 12th and 13th January, 1972 at 7.30 a.m.

FINAL QUALIFYING EXAMINATION
