ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICERS' HALF-YEARLY QUALIFYING EXAMINATION

The next written examination for the Administrative Class in terms of Appendix II of the Establishment Secretariat Circular letter No. AG/54 of 4th June, 1954, will be held on Friday, 4th February, 1972, at the times specified below:

2. Candidates (other than those who have been awarded the Diploma by the Institute of Public Administration) should apply to their Regional Administrative Officers/Principal Secretaries. The closing date by which names of candidates should reach the Secretary, Public Services Commission, is 22nd January, 1972.

MINISTRY OF HEALTH—MANPOWER AND TRAINING DIVISION SCHOLARSHIP FOR TRAINING AS OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST

Applications are invited for three scholarship awards for a three-year course of training in the United Kingdom leading to the Diploma of the Association of Occupational Therapists. The award is to enable the selected candidates to qualify for eventual appointment in the Ministry of Health as Occupational Therapists on Salary Range 45, 50, i.e. NC1,488-NC2,124 per annum.

- 2. Candidates will be bonded to return to Ghana on successful completion of their studies and to serve Government for a period of not less than five years; or in default to pay Government the amount forfeited under the bond plus 5 per cent interest.
 - 3. Qualifications-
 - (a) Candidates who must be male or female must be citizens of Ghana;
 - (b) must possess the minimum educational qualification of the General Certificate of Education at the Advanced Level or Ordinary Level with passes in 5 subjects, including English Language or Literature, a Science Subject and Fine Arts or similar subjects; or
 - (c) must possess an equivalent educational qualification; and must have a sincere and genuine interest in the welfare of people and in medicosocial problems;
 - (d) must have attained their 21st birthday but not have reached their 35th birthday on 30th January, 1972.
