VACANCY FOR ASSISTANT CATERING OFFICER

Applications are invited from suitably qualified persons for appointment as Assistant Catering Officer in the Game and Wildlife Department.

Salary Scale.—Range 35, 40 (i.e. ₵1,008–₵1,428.)

Duties.—Overall supervision and management of catering and accommodation facilities in the Mole Game Reserve, including the Mole Motel. Preparation of menus and purchasing of food supplies, furnishing materials and other equipment. Responsibility for the supervision of cooks and stewards and the maintenance of cleanliness in the motel.

Qualifications.—Candidates who must be women between the ages of 25 and 40 must possess either—

- (a) a Diploma or Certificate in Institutional Management issued by a recognised body, or
- (b) the City and Guilds 151 or 152 Certificate, or
- (c) the City and Guilds 147 or 150 Certificate followed by at least two years' practical experience in a recognised catering establishment.

Application forms may be obtained from the Secretary, Public Services Commission, P.O. Box 1618, Accra, as well as from all Regional Administrative Offices. Completed forms should be returned to reach the Secretary, Public Services Commission, P.O. Box 1618, Accra, not later than 16th March, 1973. Only copies of certificates should be sent. Civil Servants should apply through their Heads of Departments. Persons under any form of bond are ineligible.
