- 2. The Electoral Commission has today, 12th May, 2004, in accordance with Article 112 of the 1992 Constitution, as amended by Section 3 of Act. 527, the Constitution of Ghana (Amendment) Act. 1996 and Regulation Denkyira Constituency.

- 5. Every nomination must be proposed and seconded by two (2) registered voters respectively and supported by eighteen (18) other registered voters from the constituency, and the consent of the candidate must be endorsed thereon.
