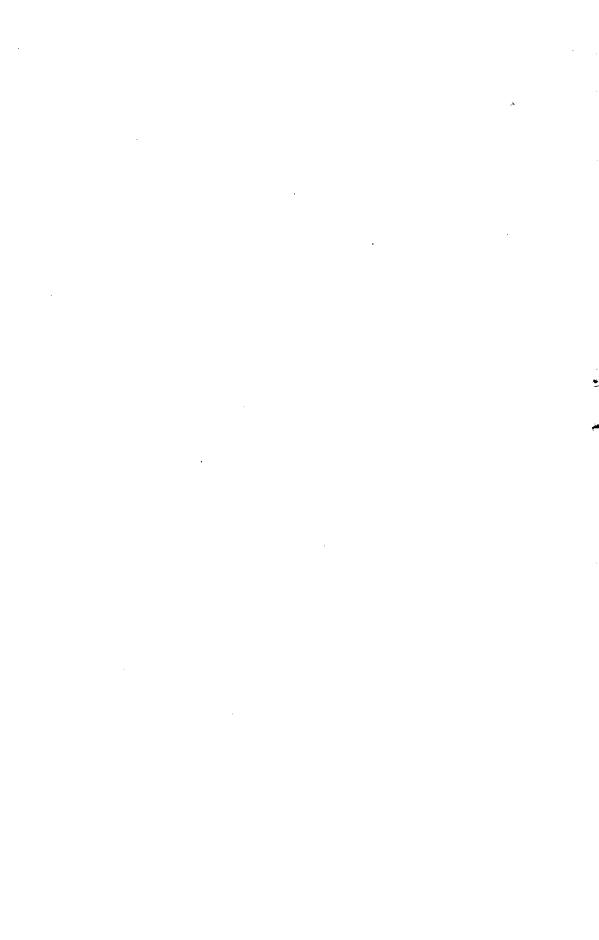

# THE EQUALIZATION FUND APPROPRIATION ACT, 2018

#### No. 3 of 2018

Date of Assent: 4th April, 2018

Date of Commencement: 7th May, 2018

AN ACT of Parliament to authorize the issue of a sum of money out of the Equalization Fund and its application towards the service of the year ending 30th June, 2018 and to appropriate that sum for certain public basic services and for connected purposes

ENACTED by the Parliament of Kenya, as follows—

1. This Act may be cited as the Equalization Fund Appropriation Act, 2018 and shall come into force on the date of publication.

Short title.

2. The Equalization Fund Secretariat may issue the sum of eleven billion, nine hundred and seventy-seven million, seven hundred and sixty-four thousand, six hundred and eighty-eight shillings, out of the Equalization Fund and apply it towards the supply granted for the service of the year ending on the 30th June, 2018.

Issue of Ksh. 11, 977,764,688 out of the Equalization Fund for the service of the year ending

30th June, 2018.

3. The sum granted under section 2 shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from 1st July, 2017 for the basic services under Article 204(1) of the Constitution and as further provided for in the Public Finance Management Act, 2012 and the Equalization Fund Guidelines, 2015 for the Equalization Fund Secretariat and counties specified in the first column of the Schedule and for the several services specified in the second column of the Schedule, in the amounts specified in the third column of the Schedule.

Appropriation of the money granted.

4. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of this Act, the approval granted under section 2 shall continue in force until all the projects in each county specified in the first column of the Schedule are completed and this Act shall be sufficient authority for the Controller of Budget to authorize withdrawal of funds from the Equalization Fund for the amounts specified in the third column of the Schedule for each county specified in the first column of the schedule, where the projects are implemented for a

period beyond one financial year.

The approval granted shall not lapse until the projects in each county specified in the first column are completed.

(2) The approval by the Controller of Budget of a withdrawal from the Equalization Fund, together with written instructions from the National Treasury requesting for the withdrawal, is sufficient authority for the Central Bank of Kenya to pay amounts from the Equalization Fund Account in accordance with the approval and instructions.
