AN ORDINANCE

Enacted by His Majesty's Commissioner for the East Africa Protectorate.

No. 2 of 1906.

Game.

IT is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. Section 6 Sub-Section 1 of the "Game Ordinance 1904" is hereby repealed.
2. Every license, except a Public Officers fourteen day license, issued under the "East Africa Game Regulations 1900" or under the "Game Ordinance 1904" and unexpired on the 30th day of March 1906 shall remain in force for one year from the date of issue ; but such license shall after the first day of April 1906 be subject to the provisions of every Ordinance, Regulation, Proclamation or Rule relating to the preservation of Game which may then be in force or which may thereafter during the currency of such license come into force in the East Africa Protectorate.
3. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Game Ordinance 1906."

DISEASES OF ANIMALS ORDINANCE 1906.

Whereas I have been advised that the area hereinafter described is now free from Sheep Pox I hereby declare my Proclamation under the above Ordinance dated December 14th 1905 and published in the "Official Gazette" of December 15th 1905, whereby the land owned by Mr. Walmisley and then occupied by Mr. Edwards situate in the district of Naivasha was declared an infected area and whereby the movement of any cattle sheep or goats from or into the said area was prohibited, to be hereby cancelled.

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Births and Deaths Registration Ordinance 1904 I hereby extend the provisions of the said Ordinance relating to the compulsory registration of deaths to all persons of European, American, or Indian origin or extraction within the East Africa Protectorate and to all natives resident or being within any Township area, and I hereby order that the death of every person of European, American, or Indian origin or extraction occurring within the East Africa Protectorate after the publication of this Order, and of every native occurring within any Township area after the publication of this Order shall be registered in accordance with the provisions of the aforesaid Ordinance.
