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## EAST AFRICA PROTECTORATE.

### Proclamation.

(Under the Diseases of Animals Ordinance 1906.)

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by Section 6 of the Diseases of Animals Ordinance 1906 I hereby prohibit the introduction into the East Africa Protectorate of donkeys from German East Africa, and I further prohibit the introduction into the East Africa Protectorate from German East Africa of the carcasses, hides, skins, hair or wool of any animal unless such carcass, hides, skins, or wool shall have first been disinfected in the manner prescribed by and to the satisfaction of an Inspecting Officer, as defined by the Rules issued under the aforesaid Ordinance, at the place of introduction.
