Diseases of Animals.

IT is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Diseases of Animals Amendment Ordinance 1906" and shall be read as one with "The Diseases of Animals Ordinance 1906"
2. The Diseases of Animals Ordinance 1906 shall be amended to the following extent :—
 - (1) To the diseases specified in section 2 sub-section (4) there shall be added "Rabies" and "Epizootic Lymphangitis" and there shall be omitted from the said diseases "Ulcerative Lymphangitis."
 - (2) For the words "and any other contagious or infectious disease of animals" at the close of the last mentioned sub-section there shall be substituted the words "and any other contagious or infectious disease of animals that the Commissioner may by Proclamation declare to be included in the definition for the purpose of this Ordinance."
 - (3) From section 5 sub-section (2) there shall be omitted the words "or into."
3. The "Diseases of Animals Amendment Ordinance No. 12 of 1906" is hereby repealed

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that return concession tickets available between Sunday, January 20th, and Tuesday, January 29th, 1907, both days inclusive, will be issued for 1st, 2nd and Intermediate class passengers at following reduced rates to Nairobi only, viz:—

For outward distance not less than 100 miles, 1st and 2nd class tickets at single fare for double journey.

Intermediate class tickets, at a fare and a fourth for a double journey.

Horses and ponies attending the Nairobi Races, at a single fare for the double journey, irrespective of distance.

UGANDA PROTECTORATE.

Rules

Made by His Majesty's Commissioner under the Uganda Outlying Districts Ordinance 1904.

1. The conditions under which the licenses will be granted to travellers desirous of entering the Nile Province or any district of the Nile Province proclaimed as an Outlying District shall be as follows:—

- (1) All persons entering the Nile Province, or any district of the Nile Province declared as an Outlying District, will do so through the stations of Nimule or Gondokoro.
- (2) Each person will deposit with the Collector of Nimule, or Gondokoro, a sum not exceeding Rs. 500, as the Collector shall specify on the Licence or furnish security to the satisfaction of the Collector as surety for good behaviour in the district covered by the Licence.
- (3) No person will be allowed to take into any outlying districts, rifles more modern than a Martini.

This Rule will not affect persons who have taken out a Game Licence under the Regulations so far as their personal arms are concerned.

- (4) On returning from the Outlying Districts covered by the Licence, traders and others must pass through Nimule, or Gondokoro, to have their Licences checked, and to recover the amount of their deposits, which will be liable to forfeiture if the conditions of the Licence are not observed.
