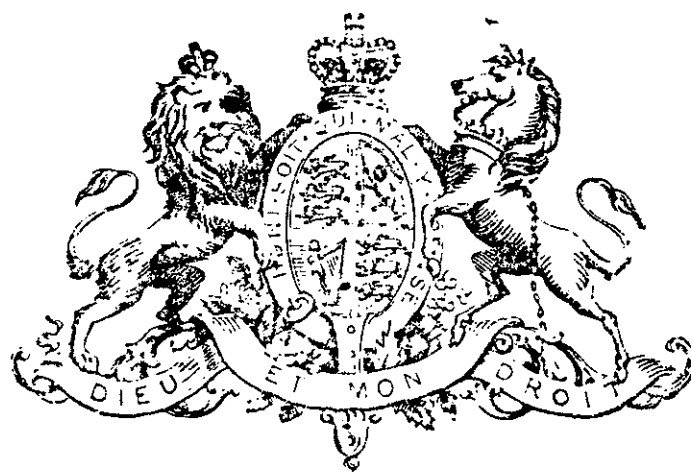

ERRATA.

The following is published in continuation of the Notice of the 7th May, 1908, relating to the conditions under which land will be granted.

1. Before any land can be allotted, the applicant must show that he is possessed of means at least equal to the amount he will be required to spend on development.

Farm buildings of all descriptions.

Walls.

Draining land, or reclamation of swamp.
Roads.
Bridges.
Clearing of land for agricultural purposes.
Laying out and cultivating gardens and nurseries.
Water boring.
Water races.
Sheep or cattle dips.
Embarkments or protective works of any kind.
Planting of long lived crops.
Water tanks.
Fixed machinery.
Irrigation works.

3. The possession of live stock, implements and movable machinery, will not count towards development; but they may be shown in proof of means for the acquisition of land.
