EAST AFRICA PROTECTORATE.

PROCLAMATION.

Under the East Africa Outlying Districts Ordinance, 1902.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by the East Africa Outlying Districts Ordinance 1902, I Colonel Sir Edouard Percy Cranwill Girouard, K.C.M.G., D.S.O., R.E., Governor of the East Africa Protectorate, with the approval of His Majesty's Secretary of State for the Colonies, do hereby proclaim all the district described in the Schedule hereto to be a closed district for the purposes of the above Ordinance. The Proclamation published in the "Official Gazette" and dated 18th June, 1906, is hereby repealed so far as it effects the Machakos (Ulu) Native Reserve.

Schedule.

Machakos (Ulu) Native Reserve.

Commencing at the summit of Muani Hill (3 miles to the East of Sultan Hamud Station) thence bounded by a line in an Easterly direction round the base of the Moona Hills, thence by a line in a North Easterly direction across the summits of the Matha Hills to a dry water course (which rises in the North Easterly extremity of this range), thence by this dry water course to its junction with the Ndangi River (also known as the Kiangini), thence by the South Bank of the Ndangi River to its junction with the Athi River thence by the centre of the Athi River up stream to a point where it is joined by the Mutwoyi River, thence by the Mutwoyi River to a point on line produced between the Northerly corner of Farm No. 361 (Mr. Webber's farm) and Koma Rock, thence by a line through the summit of Koma Rock to the Northerly Corner of Farm No. 361, thence by the Easterly boundary of Farm No. 361 to its South Easterly Corner, thence by a line in a Southerly direction across the Northern end of the Mua Hills to the source of the Movunguni stream and at a point where the Athi River Station-Machakos Road crosses it, thence by that road to the Machakos Township Boundary, thence by that Township Boundary (excluding the Township) to the Kapiti Plains Station-Machakos Road, thence by that Road crossing the Moruba River to its intersection with the Machakos Station-Machakos Road, thence by that road to its intersection or crossing of a dry water course, some 3 miles South of Momba River bridge, thence by a line in a South Easterly direction to the central peak of the Momandu Hills thence by a line to the central peak of the Ndalgiti Hills, thence by a line to the central peak of the Kiu Hills, thence by a line to the Muani Hill and point of commencement.

PROCLAMATION.

Districts of Mombasa and Malindi.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by the East Africa Order-in-Council 1902 and with the consent of the Secretary of State for the Colonies I, Edouard Percy Cranwill Girouard, K.C.M.G., D.S.O., R.E., Governor of the East Africa Protectorate, do hereby declare that from the date hereof the boundary between the Districts of Mombasa and Malindi will be as follows:—

A line running from the Southern corner of the village of Kijangwani on the Coast to the Northern end of the village of Kurwitu, thence in a Westerly direction skiting the North end of the villages of Gulani and Ziwani, thence to the Southern foot of Cha Simba Hill, thence through Birini to the Northern extremity of Kibobwani, thence along the path which passes through the villages of Kafilani and Maremairi but skirting those villages so as to include them in the Malindi District, thence along the aforementioned path to a point two miles to the South of Kaya Fungo where the path leading to Rabai from Kaya Fungo intersects the recognized boundary between the Mtsarani and Tiwi Native Districts, thence by a line running in a North Westerly direction to Mbung:, thence to a point half way between Maziwa Matatu and the Sabaki.

The proclamation dated 8th day of December 1904 and published in the "Official Gazette" of 15th December, 1904, is hereby cancelled.
