# PROCLAMATION.

#### The Forest Ordinance 1911

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by Section 3 of the Forest Ordinance, 1911, I hereby declare the areas hereinafter defined to be Forest Areas for the purpose of the aforementioned Ordinance namely —

The forests situated on the slopes of the Kikuyu Escarpment and known as the Kikuyu Forests and bounded as follows —

# Under the Diseases of Plants Prevention Ordinance, 1910.

Regulations issued by His Excellency the Acting Governor of the East Africa Protectorate under the powers conferred by the above mentioned Ordinance Nairobi,

1 No person shall import into the Protectorate any plant from Ceylon

Any plant imported into the Protectorate in breach of the provisions of these Regulations may be seized by any Officer of Customs or by the Director of Agriculture or any Officer acting on his behalf

Any plant seized as aforesaid shall be destroyed or otherwise dealt with as the Director

of Agriculture shall determine

- Any person who shall import any plant in breach of the provisions of these Regulations shall be liable to a fine not exceeding 750 rupees or to imprisonment of either description for a term not exceeding two months
- 3 In these Regulations, the term "plant" includes growing trees, plants or portions thereof, such as cuttings, buds, roots, tubers, seeds, truit, and vegetables
