



WHEREAS by an Indenture of Lease made the 17th day of December 1909 BETWEEN His late Most Gracious Majesty King Edward Seventh of the one part and the Right Honourable George Horatio Charles Cholmondeley Earl of Rocksavage of Houghton Hall, King's Lynn in the county of Norfolk, England, (therein referred to as the Lessee) of the other part ALL THAT piece or parcel of land situated and lying between the Moyo and Rongai Rivers in the Nyeri District of the Kenya Province of the East Africa Protectorate comprising 10,030 acres or thereabouts and therein described was demised unto the Lessee for a term of 99 years as therein mentioned AND WHEREAS the Lessee covenanted to use the said land for the purposes of grazing and agriculture AND WHEREAS the Lessee by an implied covenant by virtue of Section 14 (e) of the Crown Lands Ordinance, 1902, covenanted to use and develop the natural resources of the land leased with all reasonable speed having regard to all the circumstances of the case AND WHEREAS the Lessee has failed to use the said land for the purposes of grazing and agriculture and has committed a breach of the Lessee's covenant implied by virtue of Section 14 (e) of the said Crown Lands Ordinance, 1902, NOW THEREFORE by virtue of the provisions of Section 18 (1) of the said Crown Lands Ordinance, 1902, I, Henry Conway Belfield, C.M.G., Governor of the East Africa Protectorate, do hereby give notice to the said Lessee that I intend after one month from the publication of this notice to commence an action in the High Court for a declaration that the said lease be forfeited

CIRCULAR

1 The question of the diet ordinarily issued to native labourers in the Protectorate and its effect on their general health has been engaging the attention of Government

2 It is generally recognised that sickness or ill-being is liable to follow the consumption of imperfectly cooked food and that monotony of diet re-acts prejudicially on the individual

3 Employers are, therefore, recommended to take precautions to ensure that the rations issued to those who work for them are properly cooked by the latter before they are consumed. Where large numbers are employed, they ought to be divided into gangs and a member from each detailed as cook for his party and provided with the necessary utensils. It is also of importance to introduce variety in the food given and to issue a ration of a composite character

OBITUARY.

His Excellency the Governor regrets to announce the death of Sir Clement Lloyd Hill, K.C.B., K.C.M.G., M.P., Superintendent of East African Protectorates under the Foreign Office from 1900-1905

Sir Clement Hill was intimately associated with the early history of British East Africa and always took the keenest interest in questions affecting it. He was also a member of the Uganda Railway Committee from 1896. Officers who served under him will feel the loss of a sympathizer and a friend. As a member of the House of Commons he was a close student of events in this country and his experience entitled him to speak with weight on such subjects. His name will always be bound up with the development of the Protectorate, in promoting which many of the best years of his life were spent.

OBITUARY.

His Excellency the Governor announces with regret the death of Mr D J Wilson, late Director of Government Transport, Principal Immigration Officer, and Coast Agent for the Uganda Protectorate, which took place at Mombasa on Sunday the 6th inst.

Mr Wilson first came to East Africa in 1889 as Superintendent of Telegraphs in the Imperial British East Africa Company's Service. When the Protectorate was formed in 1895 he joined the administration and subsequently held the offices enumerated above eventually retiring in 1911. His work brought him into contact with practically all the members of the services of both Protectorates and his unfailing kindness and courtesy, particularly to new comers, endeared him to all those with whom he had to deal. He will be sincerely mourned by a wide circle of friends and there are few who have served in East Africa to whom the news of his death will not bring a sense of personal loss.

1 Europeans only shall be allowed to bid and purchase
2 Each plot will be auctioned separately, and no purchaser or body shall be allowed to purchase more than two plots

3 The highest bidder shall be the purchaser, and, if any dispute arises as to any bidding, the plot shall be put up again at the last undisputed bidding. The amount of the advance of each bidding shall be regulated by the Auctioneer and no bidding shall be retracted.

4 Each purchaser shall pay to the Officer representing Government immediately after the sale a deposit of 25% on his purchase money, and shall pay the residue of the purchase money to the Land Officer, Nairobi, on or before the 31st May, 1913. If a purchaser shall fail to pay the residue of the purchase money on or before the 31st May, 1913, the sale shall be void, and the deposit of 25% shall be forfeited to Government. Rent payable to 31st December, 1913, survey fees Rs 40, and fees payable for preparation of deeds Rs 30 will be payable with the balance of the purchase money, and any re-sale of the plots hereby offered for sale, prior to the granting of the lease, shall render the sale under these conditions void, and all payments made thereunder shall be forfeited to the Government.

5 On payment of the residue of the purchase money the purchaser shall be entitled to enter into immediate occupation, and as soon thereafter as circumstances admit a formal lease shall be granted. The term of such lease, which shall be for 99 years, and the rent payable thereunder shall commence to run as from the 1st June, 1913.

6 Each purchaser shall erect within two years from the commencement of his lease one building only with the necessary offices and outbuildings on his plot of approved design suitable to the locality to be built of stone, brick, concrete, or wood and corrugated iron.

7 No building shall be erected on any plot unless the plans, drawings and elevations thereof shall have been previously submitted to and approved by the Land Officer or such other person as he may appoint

8 No building on a European Plot shall at any time during the term of the lease be used for any purpose other than a private dwelling-house, or occupied by a person or persons other than a European, or used as a place of residence for Asiatics or Natives who are not domestic servants in the employ of the lessee

9 Each lease shall contain a covenant against assigning, subletting or otherwise parting with the possession of the premises or any part thereof without the previous consent of the Governor in writing, and also a covenant to pay Rs 15/- for every such consent

10 If a purchaser fails to complete the buildings within the said period of two years he shall either (a) pay as liquidated and ascertained damages for such default, and not as a penalty, the sum of Rs 15/- per day for every day after the expiration of such two years until such completion, or (b) voluntarily and unconditionally surrender his lease and all expenses incurred thereunder. The lease of each plot shall contain a covenant on the part of the purchaser in the above terms, and also a proviso for re-entry on the breach of any of the covenants by the purchaser of the lease

11 Each purchaser shall bear the cost of the deeds, stamps, registration and survey fees, and all other expenses, if any, connected with the purchase

12 So far as applicable the above conditions shall be embodied in each lease
