PROCLAMATION.

The East Africa Outlying Districts Ordinance, 1902

WHEREAS by a Proclamation dated the 30th day of May, 1906, certain areas within the Naivasha Province as therein defined were declared to be Closed Districts under the East Africa Outlying Districts Ordinance, 1902 NOW THEREFORE I, Henry Conway Belfield, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor of the East Africa Protectorate, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under the East Africa Outlying Districts Ordinance, 1902, do hereby declare that the area mentioned in the Schedule hereto attached and which is located in the Naivasha Province is excluded from the provisions of the above mentioned Ordinance

NOTICE**EUROPEAN WAR**

The following telegrams have been received from the Secretary of State during the week:—

December 28th

Official News —British seaplanes escorted by light cruisers, destroyers and submarines attacked Cuxhaven 25th, discharging bombs on points of military significance. Hostile attack on our ships by enemy's aircraft, submarines, and two Zeppelins was outmanoeuvred, Zeppelins easily put to flight by our fire. On 24th British biplane successfully dropped bombs on German airship sheds Brussels. French Government report attacks and counter attacks and bombardment of Germanaviator sheds near Metz. Russian Government reports Austrians defeated Upper Vistula and in direction of Dukla with enormous losses including ten thousand prisoners.

December 30th

Official News —French Government report advance at various points including captures village St Georges in Belgium and investment Steinbach in Alsace, also loss section of trenches South of Ypres. Russian Government report Germans evacuated left bank Bzura, further successes obtained against Austrians of whom fifty thousand captured last half December.

January 1st

Official News —Battleship "Formidable" sunk this morning in channel either

by mine or submarine, 71 survivors so far picked up by British light cruiser, possible that others rescued by other vessels. French Government reports capture of trenches at various points and village Steinbach Upper Alsace entered by French troops who carried half village house by house. Flight Commander Hewlett, missing after raid on Cuxhaven, safely landed in Holland.

December 31st

Official News —French Government reports slight progress Nieupoit district, capture of point d'appai. South-east Zonnebeke and somewhat marked progress in Champagne. Russian Government reports desperate fighting with Germans at several points, enemy repulsed, victorious progress in Western Galicia and South-west of Dukla.

January 2nd

Official News —French Government reports action chiefly confined artillery and night attack on Metz station by aeroplane. Russian Government reports German offensive checked various points, enemy suffering heavy losses, successful operations against Austrians Western Galicia.
