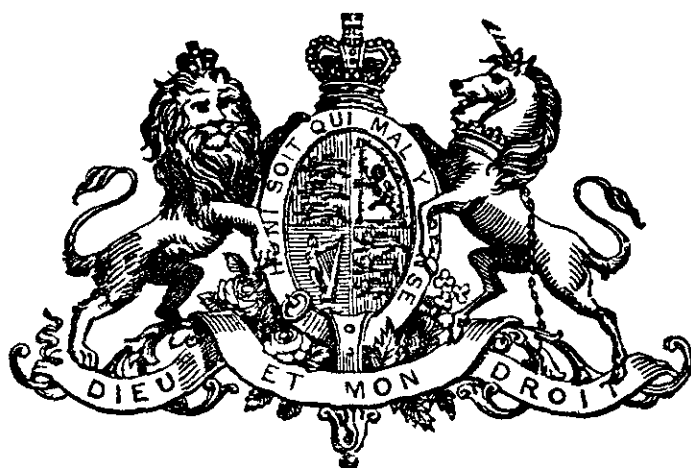

5%

FOR THE SALE OF GENERAL GOODS —

When the amount realised does not exceed Rs 100	10%
When the amount realised does not exceed Rs 1,000	7½%
When the amount realised exceeds Rs 1,000	5%

When the sale is subject to a reserve price and such price is not attained, the auctioneer may charge a commission not exceeding a sum calculated on the reserve price at half the rate hereinbefore provided for the class of property or goods to be sold

NOTICE.**EUROPEAN WAR.**

The following telegrams have been received from the Secretary of State during the week:—

April 26th

Official News —General attack Dardanelles resumed yesterday by fleet and army, army's landing covered by fleet began before sunrise at various points on Gallipoli Peninsula despite serious opposition from strong entrenchments protected by barbed wire and was completely successful, large forces established on shore before night, landing of army and advance continue. French Government reports counter attacks near Ypres have regained part of lost ground, village of Lizeiz captured by Germans on left Yser canal, recaptured by Zouaves and Belgian carabineers, appreciable progress made on right bank of Canal, British troops have maintained all their positions on our right, enemy attacks in Champagne, Argonne and heights of Meuse failed

April 27th

Official News —Following reports from General French No 1 dated Monday severe fighting northeast of Ypres continues, general situation unchanged original forced French retirement compelled our left flank face north and extend west beyond St Julien, our line thus temporarily weakened and after gallant resistance by Canadians against superior numbers, St Julien was captured by enemy, East of Ypres our troops have borne brunt of repeated heavy attacks in entirely unexpected situation, attacks also delivered on Sunday by enemy East of Ypres Salient, enemy used asphyxiating gases but attacks repulsed and German officers and men captured during last three days, very heavy casualties inflicted on enemy, our losses also heavy, German wireless report that four English heavy guns captured untrue. No 2 dated Tuesday Yesterday all German attacks northeast of Ypres repulsed in afternoon, our troops took offensive progressing near St Julien and west therefrom, French co-operated and further north retook Hetsas, during yesterday our artillery several times inflicted severe casualties upon enemy, our airmen have bombarded successfully station and junctions at Courtrai, Turcoing, Roubaix, Roulers, etc. French Government reports German attacks on heights of Meuse completely defeated whole position of Les Epaiges remains in French hands, slopes covered with German corpses. Russian Government reports bombardment Bosphorus fort by Black Sea fleet, great explosions caused in one fort, desperate battle proceeding since 24th in direction of Stryi

April 28th

Official News —Following published here "After days hard fighting troops landed Gallipoli Peninsula thoroughly making good their footing with effective help of navy, French taken advance, continues" French Government reports progress French and British forces north of Ypres continues, Germans suffered severe losses, over six hundred dead counted at one point near canal, several hundred prisoners, and six quick firing guns captured, on front Les Epaiges German attacks completely driven back, offensive assumed and progress made, nearly thousand dead Germans counted at one point, summit Hartmannsweilerkopf taken by Germans and then recaptured, War Office states officially reported on medical evidence that Canadian soldiers have been killed in recent fighting not from wounds but from poisoning by gas used by enemy contrary to Hague Convention

April 29th

Official News —Our troops, despite continual opposition, now established across end of Gallipoli Peninsula from South East Eski Hissarlik to mouth of stream on opposite side, they have also beaten off all attacks at Sari Bair and are advancing steadily, Turkish preparations to hamper landings included wire entanglements under sea and on land also deep pits with spikes at bottom

General French reports fighting north east Ypres continued throughout Tuesday, German attacks definitely stopped, no Germans west of Canal except at small bridges head Steinstraat, in resisting counter attacks Germans again used asphyxiating gases and shells contravening Hague Convention. French Government reports armoured cruiser "Leon Gambetta" torpedoed at entrance Otranto Straits, all Officers perished at their posts, four enemy aeroplanes captured or destroyed, dirigible at Friedrichshafen bombed by French airmen. Russian Government reports increased activity on Niemen front, enemy attacks Uzsook Pass repulsed with heavy losses, desperate engagements in progress near Stryi

April 30th

Official News —French Government reports hundred and fifty enemy, two machine guns captured right bank Yser Anship, probably Zeppelin, passed over Ipswich and Bury St Edmunds last night dropping five bombs, no lives lost. Russian Government reports further increased activity round Niemen front, unsuccessful enemy attacks various points, Poland, Carpathians and Stryi

May 1st

Official News —Following issued by War Office and Admiralty regarding Dardanelles operations 25th to 29th, Disembarkation of army on six different beaches began before sunrise 25th covered by whole fleet, immediately successful on five beaches, on 6th Seddel Bahr troops could not advance until evening when fine attack British infantry relieved pressure Result strong forces established three points, Australian and New Zealand troops North of Caba Tepe, British Cape Tekeh, Cape Helles, Morto Bay, French Kumkale On 26th Seddel Bahr village stormed by British frontal attack, position was made of trenches, pits and entanglements, 26th allied forces advancing, established entrenched line from 2 miles North of Cape Tekeh to Plateau above Detoto battery, advance since made to near Krithia, Australian and New Zealand forces fought with fine spirit and determination and after repulsing repeated attacks of fresh Turkish division preceded by heavy artillery fire resumed offensive, French at Kumkale repulsed four strong counter-attacks on 26th retaining all their positions and taking five hundred prisoners Army casualties necessarily heavy, fleet casualties not numerous, intervention of Turkish warships from Nagara prevented by "Queen Elizabeth" who on 27th destroyed Turkish Transport at 3rd shot, 28th and 29th allies rested and consolidated positions, continued disembarkation stores and artillery, all counter-attacks repulsed Fleet engaged batteries, "Triumph" bombarded Maidos which was in flames

May 2nd

Official News —German guns bombarded Dunkirk yesterday, their position verified by aircraft reconnaissance and position attacked and bombed General French reports French counter-attacks on our left in neighbourhood of Ypres made sensible progress German aeroplane

brought down in our lines east of Ypres French Government reports progress North of Ypres on whole front on depth varying 500 metres to Kilometre, two successive lines of trenches captured with numerous prisoners Russian Government reports further unsuccessful German attack in Northern Poland Austrian night attack North of Uzsok pass defeated, in direction Stryi, Russians took offensive attacked enemy trenches capturing 4,000 prisoners German steamer "Macedonia," which escaped from Canary Islands, captured by British cruiser

May 3rd

Official News —Admiralty reports small actions North Sea on Saturday, British destroyer "Recruit" sunk by submarine, four officers and 21 men saved, Trawler "Colombia" attacked and sunk by two German torpedo boats which were subsequently chased by British destroyers, both German vessels sunk after one hour's running fight, no casualties in British destroyers, German officer and 44 men rescued and captured

General French reports German attacks on Hill 60 and near St Julien repulsed with heavy loss to enemy, who again used poisonous gases French Government reports several trenches and 130 prisoners captured in Argonne, minor successes at other points

Russian Government reports German invasion in direction of Libau, Russians have obtained success on Niemen front, in direction of Stryi 1,000 prisoners taken

In German South West Africa near Gidon, part of General McKenzie's forces became heavily engaged with enemy during night attack, 70 being captured next morning General McKenzie attacked dispersed enemy and pursued them for 20 miles, all our prisoners recovered, both enemy's field guns and several maxims captured with 10 officers and 200 men, enemy's forces about 800

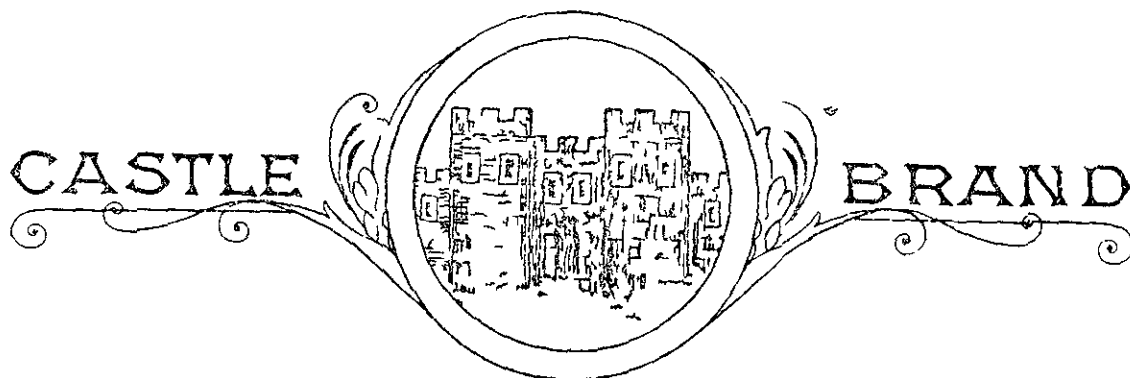
