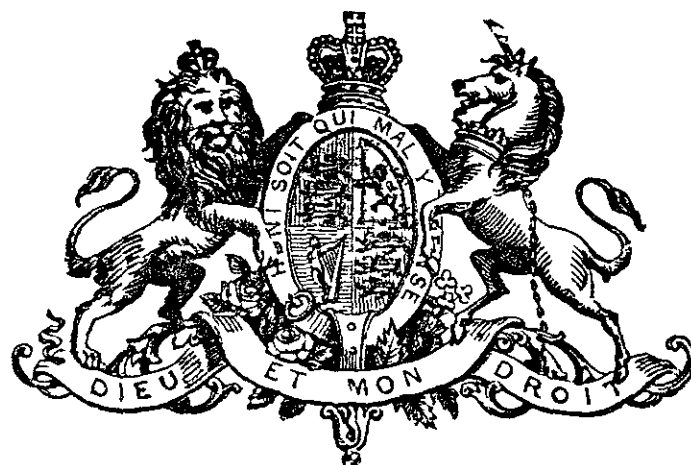

In September, 1910, he was promoted to the Headmastership of the Protectorate Day and Boarding School into which his former School was absorbed, which appointment he was holding at the time of his death
