NOTICE

THE following despatch from the Secretary of State for the Colonies is published for general information —

DOWNING STREET,
22nd October, 1917

Sir,

I have the honour to inform you that a large increase in the sums remitted to India in Money Orders and Postal Orders has been observed as a consequence of the restrictions which the Secretary of State for India in Council has been compelled to impose on trade remittances to India

2 The Government of India have accordingly decided that the value of British Postal Orders paid in India to any one individual on the same day must not exceed £20

3 As a further measure, and in consequence of an increase which has been made in the rate of exchange at which the Secretary of State for India in Council sells Council drafts on India, the rate of exchange for remittances made to India by Postal or Money Orders has been raised from 15 rupees = £1 (1s 4d the rupee) to 14 rupees 2 annas = £1, which is the equivalent to the nearest anna of the rate of 1s 5d the rupee

4 The new rates came into force on 25th September as to all Postal Orders issued in the United Kingdom, and on 26th September as to all Money Orders advised from the Imperial General Post Office

5 You will no doubt take the necessary steps to bring these measures to the notice of the public

UNDER MARTIAL LAW.

NOTICE

Control of Intoxicating Liquor.

NO person shall either himself or by any servant, or agent, sell or supply any intoxicating liquor in any licensed premises, or in any club, from Thursday next, January 17th inclusive, except as under, viz —

A FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES

- (1) Between the hours of 12 noon and 2 p m
- (2) Between the hours of 6 p m and 10 p m, provided that on special occasions a permit in writing to extend the hours to any time up to 12 midnight may be granted by a Post Commandant or Officer Administering Martial Law in his discretion

N B—On licensed premises and in any club, the consumption of intoxicating liquor is prohibited, except between the hours mentioned above

B FOR CONSUMPTION OFF THE PREMISES, i e (BY BOTTLE, CASE, CASK, ETC)

To any person whatsoever, whether if delivered at the residence of the purchaser by the seller, or taken away by the purchaser at the time of purchase, only if signed for in a book provided for that purpose by the seller, and in which the full name and address of the purchaser, is entered with full particulars of purchase

Provided that in addition, no intoxicating liquor (by bottle, case, cask, etc), shall be sold or supplied to any member of His Majesty's Naval or Military Services (including followers), except on production of a permit authorising the purchase, which permit must bear the office stamp and the signature of the Commanding Officer, or the Adjutant of the purchaser's unit, explicitly authorising the purchase

C Intoxicating liquor despatched by train will be entered up in a special book, and the original order in writing will be filed, so as to be available for inspection, if called for

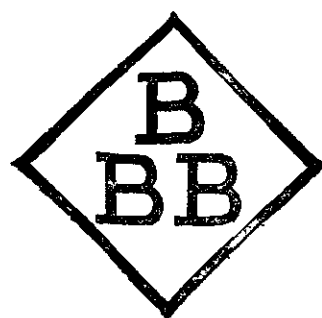
