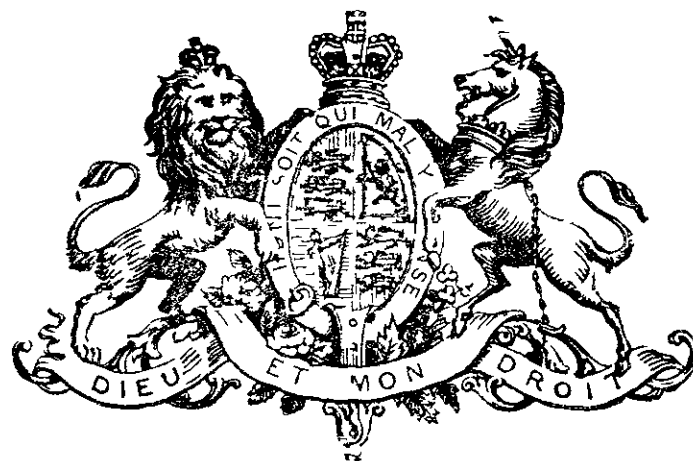

PROCLAMATION No 865

BY THE KING

A PROCLAMATION

RELATIVE TO THE IMPORTATION OF CERTAIN ARTICLES INTO THE UNITED KINGDOM
GEORGE V

WHEREAS by section forty-three of the Customs Consolidation Act, 1876, it is provided that the importation of arms, ammunition, gunpowder, or any other goods may be prohibited by Proclamation

And whereas by certain Proclamations entitled Prohibition of Import Proclamations the importation of certain goods has been prohibited accordingly

And whereas it is expedient that the importation into the United Kingdom of certain other goods should be prohibited

Now, therefore, We, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council in pursuance of the said Act and of all other powers enabling Us in that behalf, do hereby proclaim, direct and ordain as follows —

As from and after the date hereof, subject as hereinafter provided, the importation into the United Kingdom of the following articles is hereby prohibited, viz —

Cheese

Fuses, fuse components and parts

Motor spirit (including aviation spirit), kerosene (including white spirit), gas oil, fuel oil and distillates from which any of the preceding can be produced

Sugar cane

Thread lathes of 3-inches and over

Provided always, and it is hereby declared, that this prohibition shall not apply to any such goods which are imported under licence given by or on behalf of the Board of Trade, and subject to the provisions and conditions of such licence

This Proclamation may be cited as the Prohibition of Import (No 25) Proclamation, 1918

Given at Our Court at *Buckingham Palace*, this Fourth day of *June*, in
the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and eighteen, and in
the Ninth year of Our Reign

PROCLAMATION No 901

BY THE KING

A PROCLAMATION

PROHIBITING THE EXPORTATION FROM THE UNITED KINGDOM TO
SWITZERLAND OF CERTAIN ARTICLES

GEORGE V

WHEREAS it is provided by Section one of the Exportation of Arms Act, 1900, that We may by Proclamation prohibit the exportation of all or any of the following articles, namely arms, ammunition, military or naval stores, and any article which We shall judge capable of being converted into or made useful in increasing the quantity of arms, ammunition, or military or naval stores, to any country or place therein named whenever We shall judge such prohibition to be expedient in order to prevent such arms, ammunition, military or naval stores, being used against Our subjects or against any forces engaged or which may be engaged in military or naval operations in co-operation with Our forces

And whereas it is provided by Section one of the Customs (Exportation Restrictions) Act, 1914, that Section one of the Exportation of Arms Act, 1900, shall have effect whilst a state of war in which We are engaged exists as it, in addition to the articles therein mentioned, there were included all other articles of every description

And whereas by Our Proclamation dated the tenth day of May, 1917, certain articles were prohibited to be exported from the United Kingdom to, among other destinations, all destinations in Switzerland

And whereas Our said Proclamation has been varied or added to by various Orders of Council, and may hereafter be varied or added to by other Orders of Council, or We may hereafter think fit to revoke Our said Proclamation and to issue another Proclamation in lieu thereof

And whereas We judge it expedient that, in addition to such articles as may for the time being be prohibited to be exported to destinations in Switzerland under Our Proclamation aforesaid or under any like Proclamation which We may hereafter issue in lieu of Our said Proclamation, the articles hereinafter specified should also be prohibited to be exported to all destinations in Switzerland

Now therefore, We, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council in pursuance of the said Acts and of all other powers enabling Us in that behalf do hereby declare, and it is hereby declared as follows —

1 As from and after the date of this Proclamation, the articles specified in the Schedule hereto shall be prohibited to be exported to any destination in Switzerland

2 Our Proclamation made the thirteenth day of March, 1917, as amended by the Orders of Council, dated the 10th August and 27th November, 1917, relating to the exportation of certain articles to Switzerland during the present War, is hereby revoked

SCHEDULE

(2) The certificate hereinbefore mentioned shall certify the total number of animals of each specified description that may be embarked on such ship or vessel for the intended voyage and that a sufficient quantity of fit and wholesome food and water has been placed on board to provide and supply such animals during the period of the voyage

- (3) Such certificate shall also specify the port or ports of destination to which such ship or vessel is bound, the description of animals embarked, and also the number and description of animals to be disembarked at each port of destination, if more than one, and no animal, except from unavoidable cause, shall be carried beyond such port of destination
- (4) The Government Veterinary Officer, District Commissioner or the Port Officer as the case may be shall, in certifying the total number of animals of each specified description that may be embarked on the ship or vessel for the intended voyage, only certify for such number of animals as can be properly fed or watered on such ship or vessel and properly accommodated thereon without overcrowding in any part so as to cause injury or unnecessary suffering to any animal

The decision of the Government Veterinary Officer, District Commissioner or Port Officer, as the case may be as to the total number of animals of each specified description that may be embarked shall be final

WHEREAS His Majesty has been pleased, in exercise of the power in that behalf conferred on Him by Section one, sub-section one, of the Trading with the Enemy (Extension of Powers) Act 1915, by divers Proclamations and in particular by a Proclamation dated the 23rd day of May, 1916, and amended on the 16th day of January, 1918, entitled "The Trading with the Enemy (Statutory List) Proclamation," to prohibit all persons or bodies of persons, incorporated or unincorporated resident, carrying on business, or being in the United Kingdom from trading with any of the persons or bodies of persons mentioned in the List contained in the last mentioned Proclamation, such List being therein referred to as the Statutory List

And whereas by Section one, sub-section two, of the said Act it is provided that any List of persons and bodies of persons, incorporated or unincorporated with whom such trading is prohibited by a Proclamation under the said Act may be varied or added to by an Order made by the Lords of the Council on the recommendation of a Secretary of State

And whereas the Statutory List contained in the last mentioned Proclamation has been varied and added to by subsequent Orders of Council

And whereas there was this day read at the Board a recommendation from the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs to the effect that the Statutory List should be further varied and added to as set forth in the Schedule hereto

Now, therefore, Their Lordships having taken the said recommendation into consideration, are pleased to order, and it is hereby ordered,

That the Statutory List be varied and added to as set forth in the Schedule hereto

Whereof the Right Honourable Arthur James Balfour, one of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State the Controller of the Foreign Trade Department and all other persons whom it may concern, are to take notice and govern themselves accordingly
