

THE DISEASES OF ANIMALS ORDINANCE, 1996.

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS an outbreak of East Coast Fever has occurred in the Naivasha District NOW THEREFORE in exercise of the powers conterred upon the Governor by the Diseases of Animals Ordinance, 1906, I, Charles Calvert Bowling, a Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Acting Governor of the East Africa Protectorate, do hereby declare the area set out in the Schedule annexed hereto to be an infected area for the purposes of the aforesaid Ordinance —

REVISED CENSORSHIP REGULATIONS RESPECTING PAID TELEGRAMS CIRCULATING WITHIN THE EAST AFRICA AND UGANDA PROFECTORATES

IT IS hereby notified for general information that the Censorship Regulations respecting the acceptance of inland paid telegrams are now as follows—

- 2 Plain language telegrams only may be accepted. In this particular connexion attention is invited to page 73 of the East Africa Post Office Guide. Only the English, French, Italian or Swahili languages may be used.
- 3 Code and cypher telegrams cannot be accepted for transmission. Exceptionally, Bankers Remittance Telegrams may contain one code word or combination to indicate the amount of the remittance. Telegrams of this category will be chargeable as code messages.
- 4 Those abbreviated telegraphic addresses which were registered anterior to the 1st of July, 1914, and also those since registered with the approval of the Chief Censor may be used as the address or signature of inland telegrams
- 5 Any future application to register an abbreviated telegraphic address will, if in accordance with the Post Office regulations on the subject, be referred to the Chief Censor for approval
- 6 Attention is invited to the requirement of the Telegraph Regulations (vide paragraph 14 on page 78 of the East Africa Post Office Guide) that the signature and full address of the sender shall be recorded on the back of the telegraph form. In any case the Censorship Regulations require that the senders name (i.e. the surname) or his approved registered address shall appear at the end of the message
