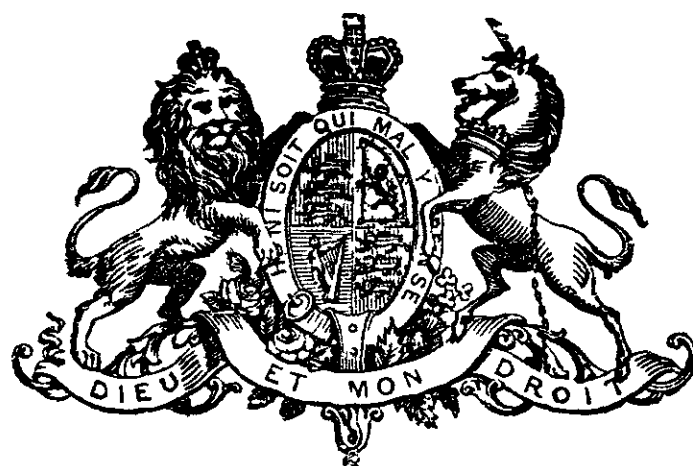

## THE EAST AFRICA TOWNSHIPS ORDINANCE, 1903.

### RULES

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon him by the East Africa Townships Ordinance, 1903, His Excellency the Acting Governor has been pleased to make the following Rules —

1 These Rules shall apply to the township of Nairobi and shall come into force on 1st January, 1919, and may be cited as “Nairobi Township (Fees, &c), Amendment Rules, 1919” They shall be read together with Nairobi Township Rules of 1917, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Rules

2 The Schedule to Section I, Part III of the Principal Rules, prescribing Slaughter House fees, shall be cancelled, and the following Schedule substituted therefor —

#### FEES FOR INSPECTION OF MEAT

	Rs	Cts
“For sheep and goats, per carcase	0	50
“For swine, and gazelles and game of every sort, per carcase	1	00
“For oxen, per carcase	1	50
“The word “ox” signifies and includes any head of horned cattle”		

3 Rule 314 of the Principal Rules, prescribing licence fees for vegetable dealers, shall be amended by substituting “Rs 5/” for “Rs 1/-”

4 Rule 341 of the Principal Rules, prescribing fees for licences of trade premises, shall be amended by substituting for the words “two rupees fifty cents” (the fee for a half year’s licence) the words “fifteen rupees” and for the words “five rupees” (the fee for a year’s licence) the words “thirty rupees”

5 The Schedule to Section I of Part V of the Principal Rules, prescribing licence fees for vehicles, shall be amended by substituting for the figure 5, under the heading of “Rickshaws for Hire” the figure 30

6 Schedule I to Section II of Part V of the Principal Rules (prescribing the licence fee for public vehicles other than rickshaws) shall be amended by substitution therein of “Rs 30” for “Rs 15”

**Telegram from the Secretary of State for the Colonies: to the Governor, British East Africa.**

The following message from Her Majesty the Queen to the Women of the Empire is forwarded for publication —

“A few months ago at the height of our anxiety and strain I sent a message in the name of the women of our lands to our men fighting for us across the seas. Now in an hour of thankfulness and hope I should like to give a message to the women of the Empire

“During the war they have been given the high privilege of service they have risen to the great opportunity and have proved their courage, steadfastness and ability

“I have been allowed to watch and appreciate their work in many parts of the country and My heart is full of admiration and gratitude for what I have seen

“I earnestly trust that though the thrill and glamour of war are over the spirit of self sacrifice and helpfulness which it has kindled will not wane in the coming days

“A new era is dawning upon the world bringing with it many difficulties, fresh responsibilities and serious problems to face

“Parliament has secured for the whole country greater opportunities of more thorough and varied education but it will depend upon the parents whether these opportunities are used to the full

“We all rejoice that plans are afoot for bringing to an end the existence of such bad and crowded housing as makes homelife almost impossible

“To-day more than ever the Empire needs her daughters for in the larger world of public and industrial work women are daily taking a more important place. As we have been united in all our work whether of head or hands in a real sisterhood of suffering and service during the war, let us go on working together with the same unity of purpose for the settlement and reconstruction of our country *MARY R*”
