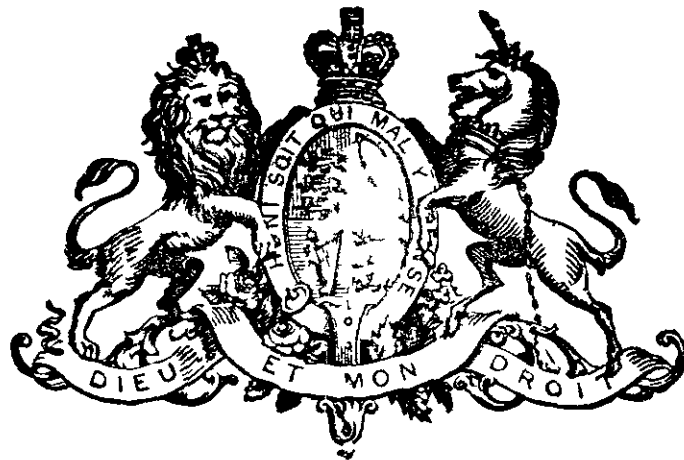

RULES

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Governor-in-Council by the Native Registration Ordinance, 1915, His Excellency the Acting Governor-in-Council has been pleased to make the following Rules —

1 These Rules may be cited as "The Native Registration (Amendment) Rules, 1919," and shall be read as one with 'The Native Registration Rules, 1919, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Rules" published on page 806 and following of the "Official Gazette" for the year 1919

2 Rule 3 of the Principal Rules and Schedule I B annexed thereto shall be and are hereby rescinded and the following Rule and Schedules I B and I C annexed to these Rules shall be substituted therefor —

"3 The Registering Officer shall fill in the details of the Certificate prescribed by Rule 2 of the Principal Rules, as also the details of the Certificate in the form set forth in Schedule I B annexed to these Rules, and shall further take the natives' finger impressions on the form set forth in Schedule I C annexed to these Rules, or on some form approximating thereto, and when duly completed and filled in manner hereinbefore directed forms I B and I C shall be attached and forwarded by the Registering Officer to the Chief Registrar of Natives"

The sub-joined definition of the African theatres of war for purposes of the award of the 1914-15 Star has been communicated by the Secretary of State for the Colonies and is published for general information

AWARD OF "1914-15 STAR"

AFRICAN THEATRE—To include all operations set forth below but excluding local military operations against Native Tribes or Rebels —

(a) In British East Africa, German East Africa, Rhodesia, Nyasaland, and Uganda, from the 20th August 1914, within an area bounded as follows —

On the North by the Uganda Railway from the Sea to Port Florence and Kisumu (including the whole of all towns actually on the Railway) thence along the North shore of Lake Victoria to the mouth of the Katonga River, thence the line of that River to Lake George

On the West by the Western Shores of Lake George, Lake Edward, Lake Kivu and Lake Tanganyika to Mohro, thence by the Northern Rhodesian-Congo Border to Lake Mweru and along the Luapula River to the 12th parallel

On the South by the 12th parallel to Lake Nyasa thence along the Western, Southern and Eastern shore of Lake Nyasa to the boundary between Portuguese and German East Africa, thence along that boundary to the Sea

(b) In German South West Africa and the 12th and 13th military districts of the Union of South Africa, provided that service was performed on the establishment of a Unit in any one of the following Forces between 20th Aug, 1914 and the 9th July, 1915,—

Northern Force—commanded by General The Right Honourable Louis Botha

"A" Force—commanded by Brigadier-General H T Lukin, C M G, D S O

"B" Force, Southern Force and Southern Army—commanded on different dates by Major-General The Honourable J C Smuts and Brigadier-General J L van Deventer

Central Force—commanded by Brig-General Sir D McKenzie, K C M G, C B V D

Eastern Force—commanded by Colonel S A L Beirange, C M G

(c) In Kamerun and that part of Nigeria east of a line from the southern extremity of Lake Chad through Maiduguri, Yola, Bakundi, Takum and Ikom (these 5 places inclusive) from Ikom eastwards along the Cross River to the Nigeria Cameroons Frontier, from the 24th August, 1914

(d) Within the boundaries of Togoland from the 7th August, 1914 to 26th August, 1914
