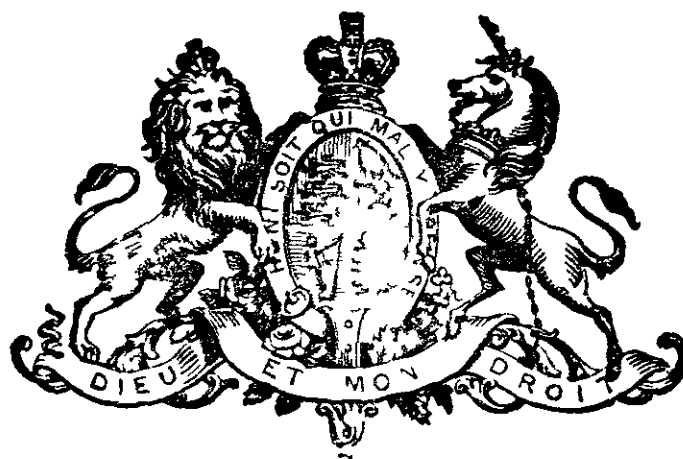

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the ‘ Appropriation Ordinance,’ 1919

2 The Public Revenue for the year 1919-20, and other funds of the East Africa Protectorate, are hereby charged towards the service of the year ending the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and twenty, with a sum of one million seven hundred and fifty two thousand nine hundred and sixty five pounds

3 The money granted by this Ordinance shall be applied to the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule annexed hereto

4 The Treasurer of the Protectorate is hereby authorised and required, from time to time, upon the warrant or order of the Governor to pay out of the Revenue and other funds of the Protectorate, for the several services specified in the Schedule, the said sum of one million seven hundred and fifty two thousand nine hundred and sixty five pounds which will come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and twenty

VOTING BY POST

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Governor by the Legislative Council Ordinance, 1919 His Excellency the Ag Governor-in-Council has been pleased to make the following Rules —

1 These Rules may be cited as "The Voting by Post Rules, 1920" and shall be read as one with "The Voting by Post Rules, 1919," herein referred to as "The Principal Rules"

2 Rule 5 (1) of the Principal Rules shall be and is hereby amended as follows —

By the deletion of the words "within the voter's electoral area" in line 5 of the said Rule and by the substitution therefor of the words "within the Protectorate"

3 Rule 5 (2) of the Principal Rules shall be and is hereby amended as follows —

After the words "Returning Officer" in the said Rule there shall be added the words "for the area in which the voter is registered"

RULES

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Governor by the East Africa Townships Ordinance, 1903, and the Infectious Diseases Ordinance, 1903, His Excellency the Acting Governor has been pleased to make the following Rules —

1 Every notice or order required or authorised by any Rules made under either of the above Ordinances to be served on any person, may be served —

(a) By delivering the same to such person

(b) By delivering the same at the usual or last known place of abode of such person or to some adult member or servant of his family

(c) A notice or order required or authorised to be served on the owner or occupier of any premises shall be deemed to be properly addressed by the description of the "owner" or "occupier" of such premises without further description

(d) Such notice may be served by delivering the same or a true copy thereof to some adult person on the premises, or if there is no such person on the premises to whom the same can with reasonable diligence be delivered, by the fixing the notice on some conspicuous part of the premises

2 In all Rules made under either of the above Ordinances the terms "owner" and "occupier" shall have the same meanings as are assigned to these terms by the Township Fees and Conservancy Ordinance, 1908
