THE INDIAN POST OFFICE ACT OF 1898

Rules

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Governor-in-Council by the Indian Post Office Act 1898, Section 43 (2) (c), His Excellency the Acting Governor has been pleased to make the following Rules —

- (1) These Rules may be cited as the Foreign Money Order Rules (No 1) 1920
- (2) The existing rates of commission upon Money Orders issued upon India, Zanzibar, British Somaliland, Tanganyika Territory, and Belgian

Congo, or negotiated with other countries through those Administrations, are hereby amended by substituting the following rates —

Commission

Rs Cts.

For sums not exceeding ten rupees 1 86

For sums exceeding ten rupees and not exceeding twenty rupees 3 60 and at the same rate, *e*, Re* 1/80 for each ten rupees, or part thereof, to the maximum amount allowed

(3) These Rules shall come into operation on the 9th day of February, 1920
