The Water Supply Department will, however, at the request of a consumer whose stand pipe is paid for at a flat rate of Rs 5/ per month, contract to execute normal repairs to the stand pipes free of charge. Repairs to stand pipes which are paid for by meter may at the request of the consumer be executed by the Railway Department, but all repairs so executed must be paid for in advance by the consumer. The Railway Department cannot accept responsibility for water wasted as the result of defects beyond the meter.
