THE DISEASES OF ANIMALS ORDINANCE, 1906

RULES

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Governor by the Diseases of Animals Ordinance, 1906, His Excellency the Acting Governor has been pleased to make the following Rules —

1 These Rules may be cited as "The Diseases of Animals (Importation of Dogs) Amendment Rules, 1920," and shall be read as one with the Diseases of Animals Rules, 1918, and all amendments thereof

2 All dogs imported from Tanganyika Territory, the Union of South Africa, Swaziland, Bechuanaland or Basutoland shall be accompanied by a certificate of health from a Veterinary Surgeon

3 All dogs imported without the certificate required by the last preceding Rule, or from any country (except Australasia and those areas of the United Kingdom not subject to restrictions on account of rabies) other than the above-mentioned shall be subjected on arrival to 4 months' quarantine at the risk and expense of the importer. Provided that the Chief Veterinary Officer may reduce the period of quarantine if he is satisfied by a certificate from a Veterinary Surgeon, that the animals have been quarantined immediately prior to embarkation and, by a certificate from the Captain of the Ship on which the dogs arrived, that they have been strictly isolated from all dogs during the voyage

4 The Diseases of Animals (Importation of Dogs) Amendment Rules (No 1) 1920, and the Diseases of Animals (Importation of Dogs) Amendment Rules (No 2) 1920, published on pages 104 and 207 respectively of the "Official Gazette" for the year 1920, are hereby revoked

THE WIRELESS TELEGRAPH
ORDINANCE, 1913

LICENCE

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon me by Section 7 of the Wireless Telegraphy Ordinance, 1913, I, Charles Calvert Bowring, Knight Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Acting Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the East Africa Protectorate, do hereby license and authorise GEORGE ERNEST HUGHES, Wireless Telegraph Engineer Operator in the service of the East Africa Post and Telegraph Department (hereinafter called the Licensee) to conduct experiments in Wireless Telegraphy and for such purpose to import wireless telegraph apparatus and instal the same at such place as the Postmaster General shall approve subject to the conditions and restrictions following, that is to say —

1 All apparatus utilized pursuant to the provisions of this licence shall be used solely for the purpose of scientific study in Wireless Telegraphy and in no case shall the Licensee instal apparatus capable of being used for the purpose of sending wireless signals, or use the receiving apparatus for the purpose of receiving either private messages or for any commercial telegraph traffic whatsoever

2 This licence shall remain in full force and operation for two years from the date hereof unless previously determined in manner hereinafter appearing

3 This licence may be determined at any time by the Governor giving to the Licensee three months' notice in writing

DESCRIPTION OF THE BOUNDARIES OF THE MACHAKOS
(ULU) NATIVE RESERVE

Commencing at the North-easterly corner of L O No 1758 on Mwani Hill, thence bounded by the generally Easterly boundaries of Farm L O Nos 1758, 1757, 1756, 1755, 1754, 1751, 1743, 1696, 1742, 1741, and to the most Northerly corner of Farm L O No 1740, thence by a line Northerly to the most Easterly corner of L O No 362, thence by the Easterly and Northerly boundaries of L O No 1491 to the Muvongoni River, thence by that River upstream to the North easterly corner of L O No 1420, thence by the generally Easterly boundaries of L O Nos 1420, 1423, 360, 361, 2366, 2365, 2360, 2709 to the most Southerly corner of L O No 1530 thence by the Southerly boundaries of L O Nos 1530, 1846, to where it intersects the Mutwori (Katala River), thence by that River down stream to its junction with the Athi River, thence by the Athi River down-stream to its junction with the Thwaki River, thence by the Thwaki River upstream to its junction with the Keite River, thence by a line South-westerly to Mathemba Hill thence by a line South-easterly to Mubau Hill thence by a line to the source of the Chunyu River, thence by that River down-stream to its junction with the Kiangini River, thence by the Kiangini River upstream to its junction with the Pungu River thence by the Pungu River upstream to its source near Ithumba Hill, thence by a line to the peak of that Hill thence by a line Westerly to a point South-east of Matha Hill where a dry water course joins the Kiopi or Mkuvu River thence by that River upstream to its junction with the Mwatimene River, thence by the Mwatimene River upstream to its intersection with the Easterly boundary of L O No 1758, thence by the Easterly boundary of that L O No to the point of commencement

SCHEDULE II

DESCRIPTION OF THE BOUNDARIES OF THE
KIKUMBULIU NATIVE RESERVE

This Reserve consists of three blocks designated as follows —

(1) MBWINZAU BLOCK

Commencing at a Beacon on the right bank of Kibwezi River (near the point where that stream

appears from under the lava sheet), thence bounded by a line bearing $272^{\circ} 20' 20''$ $27639' 2$ to a Beacon on the Uganda Railway near mile 197/12, thence by the 100' limit of Uganda Railway to a Beacon near telegraph post 200/14 thence by a line bearing $17^{\circ} 50' 17''$ $11831' 7$ to a Beacon on Muthanzau Hill thence by a line bearing $97^{\circ} 11' 20'$ $13964' 5$ to a Beacon on the Moriam Hill thence by a line bearing $128^{\circ} 31' 44'$ $27714' 5$ to a Beacon on Ngurur Hill, thence by a line bearing $190^{\circ} 44' 10''$ $7749' 7$ to Kibera (Isaguru) River, thence by that River up-stream to a point 15 feet to the West of its junction with a Southern stream bounding the area as Etiko thence by that stream 15 feet from its centre on its left bank to a Beacon, thence by a line bearing $252^{\circ} 41' 20''$ $719' 4$ to a Beacon, thence by a line bearing $48^{\circ} 11' 00''$ $110' 0$ to a Beacon, thence by a line bearing $333^{\circ} 15' 00''$ $521' 0$ to the point of commencement

(2) CHYALA BLOCK

Commencing at the most Northerly peak of Kikweo Hill thence bounded by a line South westerly to Kai Hill thence by a line North westerly to Matendeuko Hill, thence by a line North easterly to Tenda Hill thence by a line Easterly to the Mbumi River thence by that River to its junction with the Malindu River thence by a line Southerly to the point of commencement

(3) CHYULU BLOCK

Commencing at Mile Post 205 on Uganda Railway, thence bounded by the Western boundary of L O No 314 to its Southerly corner, thence by the South-westerly and Southerly boundary of L O No 315 to the most Westerly corner of L O No 316, thence by the South westerly boundary of that L O No to its Southerly corner, thence by a line South easterly to the most Westerly corner of L O No 1325 thence by the Southerly boundary of that L O No to the Northerly corner of L O No 1326, thence by the Westerly boundary of that L O No to the most Westerly corner of L O No 920 thence by the South westerly and South easterly boundary of that L O No to the 100' limit of Uganda Railway, thence by that Railway limit Southerly to the limit of Mito Anderi Station, thence by the Northerly and Westerly boundaries of that Station Reserve to its South-westerly corner, thence by a line South westerly to Mount Ngolea thence by a line to the most Southerly peak of the Chyulu (or Kivulu) Range which point forms the common boundary of the Masai Native Reserve and Ukamba and Narokha Provincial boundary thence by that common boundary to a point approximately 10 miles North-west of Chyulu Tug Station, thence by a line North-easterly to point of commencement
