THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE, 1910

PROCLAMATION

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Governor by the Customs Ordinance, 1910, Section 53, I, Edward Northey, Major-General of His Majesty's Forces, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Companion of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Governor of the East Africa Protectorate, do hereby declare that the importation of the following articles be prohibited—

The silver rupee of British India and Notes of the denomination of one rupee issued by the Government of India under the authority of the India Paper Currency (Amendment) Act, 1917 Provided that persons arriving at East Africa may be allowed to introduce small amounts to be determined by the Customs Authorities at the Port of landing at their discretion
