THE MINING ORDINANCE, 1912

REGULATIONS

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Governor by the Mining Ordinance, 1912, Section 73, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to make the following Regulations —

1 The Regulations may be cited as "The Mining Amendment Regulations, 1920," and shall be read as one with "The Mining Regulations, 1912," hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Regulations," and all amendments thereof

2 Regulation 83 of the Principal Regulations is hereby revoked and the following Regulation substituted therefor —

"83 The Commissioner of Mines may, with the approval of the Governor, grant to any person any number of sole prospecting licences to search over an area not exceeding five square miles on any specific Crown lands or on any private land to the owner thereof, or with the consent of the owner to any other person, for gold, precious stones, minerals, coal or oil "

3 For the words "six months" in Regulation 86 (1) of the Principal Regulations there shall be substituted the words "eight months " Provided that such amendment shall not affect any pending application for a sole prospecting licence, or any sole prospecting licence heretofore issued

4 Regulation 87 of the Principal Regulations is hereby revoked and the following Regulation substituted therefor —

" 87 A sole prospecting licence shall not be issued to search on land held as a prospecting claim or under a mining lease or over which the mineral rights have been protected or alienated "

5 The words "to any private land or" in form No 12 in Schedule A annexed to the Principal Regulations shall be deleted

6 Subject to proviso contained in Regulation 3 hereof all sole prospecting licences issued pursuant to any pending application, or heretofore issued shall be deemed to be valid and issued pursuant to the Principal Regulations as hereby amended

2 The Schedule annexed to the Principal Regulations and Defence Regulations (No 48) 1920 (Government Notice No 210, 1920,) respectively shall, save as regards any articles not specifically mentioned in the Schedule thereto, be and the same are hereby revoked, and the Schedule hereto substituted therefor. The maximum prices of all other articles not mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall remain as heretofore fixed until duly altered

THE BRITISH PROTECTORATES (DEFENCE)
ORDER IN-COUNCIL, 1916

REGULATIONS

Control of Petrol Distribution

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Governor by the British Protectorates (Defence) Order in Council, 1916, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to make the following Regulations

1 These Regulations may be cited as "The Defence Regulations (No 50) of 1920"

2 Regulation No 3 of Defence Regulations (No 4) of 1918, is hereby revoked and the following Regulation substituted in lieu thereof

"3 No person shall sell motor spirit to any person unless the person to whom the motor spirit is to be supplied shall produce a licence signed by a member of the Central Petrol Committee or some other person duly authorised by the Central Petrol Committee to sign such licences on their behalf, permitting motor spirit to the amount specified in the licence to be sold or supplied to the holder of the licence"

The Central Petrol Committee shall be composed of the following members —

S CULLEN-WARD, Esq

LT -COL R R COLLINGS-WELLS, D S O

The District Commissioner, Nairobi, shall be Chairman of the Committee and the Committee shall have its seat in Nairobi and shall sit to consider applications for licences at such time and in such places in Nairobi as the Chairman shall direct

3 Regulation 5 of Defence Regulations (No 4) of 1918 is hereby amended by the substitution of the words "The Central Petrol Committee or other person duly authorised to issue licences by the Central Petrol Committee shall not" for the words "No District Commissioner shall" in the first line thereof, and the words "The Central Petrol Committee or other person duly authorised to issue licences by the Central Petrol Committee" for "District Commissioner" in the third line thereof

4 Regulation 6 of the Defence Regulations (No 4) of 1918 is hereby amended by the addition of the following words

The District Commissioner shall forthwith forward such returns to the Central Petrol Commissioner and shall report to the Central Petrol Committee any petrol found by such search to be stored and not to have been made the subject of a return under these Regulations

THE WIRELESS TELEGRAPH
ORDINANCE, 1913

LICENCE

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon me by Section 7 of the Wireless Telegraphy Ordinance, 1913, I, Edward Northey, Major-General of His Majesty's Forces, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Companion of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the East Africa Protectorate, do hereby license and authorise OLIVER GOODLIFFE HARTOW, residing at Salisbury Road, Nairobi, to conduct experiments in

Wireless Telegraphy and for such purpose to import Wireless Telegraph apparatus and instal the same at such places as the Postmaster General shall approve subject to the conditions and restrictions following, that is to say —

1 All apparatus utilized pursuant to the provisions of this licence shall be used solely for the purpose of scientific study in Wireless Telegraphy and in no case shall the Licensee instal apparatus capable of being used for the purpose of sending wireless signals, or use the receiving apparatus for the purpose of receiving either private messages or for any commercial telegraph traffic whatsoever

2 This licence shall remain in full force and operation for three months from date hereof
