11. No sub-division of the plot will at any time

The purchaser shall, within one year of the commencement of the Lease, completely enclose the plot with a fence of suitable design and in conformity with the Township Regulations.

13. All outbuildings, offices, etc., shall be properly screened from view to the satisfaction of the Land Officer or such other person as he may appoint and shall be kept so screened during the term of the Lease.

14. No building may approach within a less distance than 10 feet of the boundary of the plot, and at least one-half of the plot must remain
