THE TOWNSHIPS ORDINANCES, 1903-1918.

RULES.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon him by the Townships Ordinances, 1903-1918, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to make the following Rules:—

1. These Rules may be cited as "The Mombasa Township (Building Estates) Amendment Rules, 1921," and shall be read as one with "The Mombasa Township (Building Estates) Rules, 1917," hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Rules."

2. The Principal Rules are hereby amended by the addition of the following Rules:—

(1) If any person shall without the permission in writing of the Medical Officer of Health use as a dwelling any part of a building not erected for the purpose of being used as a dwelling, he shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a penalty not exceeding Florins 400/.

(2) If any person shall refuse or neglect to obey any order in writing by the Medical Officer of Health, requiring him to cease to occupy as a dwelling any building not erected for that purpose or any part of such building, he shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding Florins 15/- for each day during which such neglect or refusal continues and may be ejected on an order made by a Magistrate.
