THE LAND TITLES ORDINANCE, 1908.

PROCLAMATION.

THE MINING ORDINANCE, 1912.

REGULATIONS.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon him by the Mining Ordinance, 1912, His Excellency the Acting Governor has been pleased to make the following Regulations.

1. These Regulations may be cited as "The Mining Amendment Regulations, 1921," and shall be read as one with "The Mining Regulations, 1912," hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Regulations."

2. Regulation 86 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion of sub-section (1) and the substitution of the following sub-section therefor:—

"86. (1) Every licensee shall employ and keep employed during eight months at least of the term of the licence in searching for gold, precious stones, minerals, coal and oil on the lands comprised in the licence such number of Europeans of or over the age of 16 as the Commissioner of Mines may require.

Provided that at least one such European shall be employed in any area or group of adjoining areas for which a licence has or licences have been issued to any one person."


