An Ordinance to Supply a further Sum of Money for the Service of the Year ending 31st of March, 1920.

BE it enacted by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Supplementary Short title. Appropriation Ordinance, 1921.

2. The Public Revenue for the year 1919-20, and other Public Revenue charged. funds of the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya are hereby charged towards the service of the year ended the 31st day of March 1920 with a further sum of five hundred and three thousand, eight hundred and forty-nine pounds, ten shillings and ten pence, in addition to the sums provided by the Appropriation Ordinance,

3. The money granted by this Ordinance shall be applied to the purposes and services expressed in the schedule annexed granted. hereto.

Application of money

The Treasurer of the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya Treasurer's authority for is hereby authorised and required, from time to time, upon warrant or order of the Governor, to pay out of the Revenue and other funds of the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya for the several services specified in the schedule, the said sum of five hundred and three thousand, eight hundred and forty-nine pounds, ten shillings and ten pence, which have come in course of payment during the year ended on 31st day of March, 1920.
