Provided that the term annual rental value shall mean the amount that could be obtained by the owner as rent each year if the building or buildings and plot concerned were leased for a periorl of not less than seven years

3 These Rules shall take effect as from the 1st day of January, 1922

MINED ARBITRAL TRIBUNAL BETWEEN THE BRITISH
EMPIRE AND BULGARIA

IN pursuance of Article 188 of the Treaty of Neurlly-sur-Seine, the Mixed Arbitral Tribunal between the British Empire and Bulgaria has been constituted and is about to commence work in London. The President is Mr. B. C. J. Loder, L. L. D., Judge of the Supreme Court of the Nether linds, the British Member is Mr. Heber Hart, K. C., L. L. D. and the Bulgarian Member is Mons. Alexander Ludskanoff, Member of the National Assembly and formerly Secretary of State in Bulgaria.

As the system of Clearing Office, has not been adopted between the United Kingdom and Bulgaria, claims in respect of disputed debts due by Bulgarians to British subjects will be dealt with directly by this Tribunal. It has also jurisdiction under Section IV ('Property Rights and Interests'') Section V ("Contracts, Prescriptions, Judgments") Section VI (Mixed Arbitral Tribunal") and Section VII ("Industrial Property") of Part X of the above Treaty

By the Treaty the High Contracting Parties have agreed that their Courts and authorities shall render to the Tribunal direct all the assistance in their power, particularly as regards transmitting notices and collecting evidence and they have also agreed to regard the decisions of the Tribunal as final and conclusive and to render them binding upon their nationals
