WE do, by this Our Commission under Our Sign Manual and Signet, appoint you, the said Sir Robert Thorne Coryndon, to be, during Our pleasure, Our Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Our Colony of Kenya, with all powers, rights, privileges, and advantages to the said Office belonging or appertaining

Duties under Letters
Patent

II And We do hereby authorise, empower, and command you to exercise and perform all and singular the powers and directions contained in certain Letters Patent bearing date at Westminster the Eleventh day of September 1920, constituting the Office of Governor and Commander-in-Chief of Our said Colony or in any other Letters Patent adding to, amending, or substituted for the same, according to such Orders and Instructions relating to the territories comprised in Our said Colony, as may have already been received or as you may hereafter receive from Us

III And We do hereby appoint that so soon as you shall have taken the prescribed Oaths and have entered upon the duties of your Office, this Our present Commission shall supersede Our Commission under Our Sign Manual and Signet bearing date the Thirteenth day of September, 1920, appointing Our Trusty and Well-beloved Sir Edward Northey, Major-General of Our Forces, Knight Commander of Our Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Companion of Our Most Honourable Order of the Bath to be Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Our Colony of Kenya

Officers and others to

IV And We do hereby command all and singular Our Officers, and loving subjects in Our Colony of Kenya, and all others whom it may concern, to take due notice hereof, and to give their ready obedience accordingly

Given at Our Court at Saint James's, this Nineteenth day of August, in the Thirteenth year of Our Reign
