THE DISEASES OF ANIMALS ORDINANCE, 1906.

RULES.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Governor by the Diseases of Animals Ordinance, 1906, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to make the following rules:—

- 1. These Rules may be cited as the Diseases of Animals Amendment Rules (No. 1) of 1923, and shall be read as one with the Diseases of Animals Rules, 1918, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Rules and all amendments thereof.
- 2. Rule 26 Sub-Rule 5 of the Principal Rules as amended in Government Notice No. 259 of 1922 is hereby cancelled and the following Sub-Rule substituted therefor:—
- (5) For the purpose of these Rules the Isiolo Quarantine Area shall include the area bounded as follows:—

Commencing at the junction of the river Uaso Narok with the river Uaso Nyiro, thence bounded by the latter river down-stream to its junction with the river Ngare Siolo (Isiolo); thence by the latter river up-stream to its junction with the Eastern Marania Eiver; thence by the latter river up-stream to its intersection with the northern boundary of L.O. No. 2794; thence by the northern boundaries of that portion and of L.O. No. 2792; thence by the western boundaries of the latter portion and of L.O. No. 2791 to the most westerly corner of the last portion; thence by a straight line north-westerly to the Trigonometrical beacon on Mukugodo Hill; thence by a straight line westerly to the summit of Olloromade Hill; thence by a straight line westerly to the most northerly corner of L.O. No. 3185; thence by the northern boundaries of L.O. No. 3185 and 2731 to the point of commencement.

BYE-LAWS.

THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS AMENDMENT ORDINANCE, 1922.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon them by the Municipal Corporations Amendment Ordinance, 1922, the Municipal Council of Nairobi, with the approval of His Excellency the Governor, have made the following Bye-laws:—

1. These Bye-laws may be cited as Nairobi (Conservancy) Bye-laws, 1923, and shall be read as one with Nairobi Township Rules 1917, and shall take effect as from 1st January, 1923.

2. The removal of the contents of receptacles from earth closets in the township shall be under the control of the Corporation.

3. In respect of every earth closet in the township there shall be payable to the Corporation by the owner of the site on which such closet is situated the monthly fee specified in the attached Schedule payable quarterly in advance on the 1st days of January, April, July and October. Provided that where the Medical Officer of Health certifies that he is satisfied that proper and suitable arrangements have been made for removal of contents of a receptacle otherwise than by the employees of the Corporation, the Town Clerk shall remit the fees due therefor in respect of periods subsequent to the date of the Medical Officer of Health's certificate.

Provided further that for the purposes of these Bye-laws the occupier of premises owned by the Government shall be deemed to be the owner of such premises.

4. Where a house remains unoccupied for a period of not less than one complete calendar month, or where with the written permission of the Medical Officer of Health a closet has been disused and closed, or the receptacle removed therefrom, and has remained out of use for a period of not less than

one complete calendar month, the Town Clerk shall, on application made within three months of the 1st day of such calendar month, make a rebate or refund of the conservancy fee applicable to such period.

5. In any action for recovery of fees under these Bye-laws, it shall not be necessary to prove that services were actually rendered by the Corporation.

6. Where judgment has been given by the Court for fees under these Bye-laws, any person further delaying to pay such fees with Court costs shall be guilty of an offence.
