The following Bill is published for information and criticism:—

A Bill

Intituled

An Ordinance to Consolidate and Amend the Law Relating to Trespass.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as The Trespass Ordinance, Short title.
1923.
2. In this Ordinance, unless inconsistent with the context Definitions.
 "Native" shall include Somali and Swahili.
- 5 "Cattle" shall include bulls, cows, oxen, heifers, calves, sheep, goats, swine, horses, mules, asses and camels.
 "Inclosed land" shall mean any lands either private or public which may be inclosed or surrounded with any fence, wall or other erection by which the boundaries thereof may be known or
 10 recognised or which may be partly enclosed or surrounded with such fence, wall or other erection and partly with a river so that the whole of the boundaries thereof can be known or recognised.
 "Prescribed area" shall mean any area prescribed by Proclamation under section 7 of this Ordinance.
- 15 3. Any person who shall without lawful excuse enter into the inclosed lands of any other person without the consent of the owner or occupier thereof or the person in charge of the same, shall be guilty of an offence and, on conviction, shall be liable to a fine not exceeding S. 150 and in default of payment, to imprisonment of either description for a term not exceeding one month; and the proof of such lawful excuse shall be upon the person charged with the offence. Penalty upon unlawful entry into inclosed lands.
- 20 4. Any person found creeping through a wire fence or tying the wires to each other, or loosening the poles or supports, may be prosecuted for an offence against this Ordinance by the owner or person under whose supervision such fence is, and on conviction shall be liable to the penalties prescribed in section 3 of this Ordinance. Damage to fences.
- 30 5. (1) When a person is seen or found committing an offence against this Ordinance the owner, occupier or person in charge of the inclosed lands or the owner or person having the supervision of the fence, as the case may be, may require him to give his name and address, and, if such person shall fail to give the same, or if such person is a native not in the employ of any
 35 Non-Native, and the person demanding his name and address has reason to believe that except by arresting him he may not afterwards be found or made answerable to justice without undue delay, trouble or expense, he may without warrant arrest him. When person committing an offence under this Ordinance, may be arrested.
 (2) A person apprehended under this section shall be taken
 40 with all practicable speed before a Magistrate and shall not be detained, without a warrant, longer than is necessary for the purpose.
 (3) A person making an arrest under the provisions of sub-section (1) of this section may make over any person so arrested
 45 to a Police Officer who shall take the person arrested with all practicable speed before a Magistrate and shall not detain him without a warrant, longer than is necessary for that purpose.
 (4) A person making over a person arrested to a Police Officer under the provisions of the last preceding sub-section shall give such Police Officer a written and signed statement
 50 setting out the circumstances under which the arrest was made.

Penalty for giving false name and address.

6. Any person who upon being required to give his name and address shall give a false or fictitious name or address shall be guilty of an offence, and, on conviction, shall be liable to the penalties prescribed in section 3 of this Ordinance.

Governor-in-Council may proclaim areas.

7. The Governor-in-Council may from time to time by proclamation prescribe any area within which the provisions of section 8 of this Ordinance shall apply. Such proclamation may exclude any tribe or class of persons from its operation or may apply exclusively to any tribe or class of persons.

Penalty for being found in prescribed area

8. (1) Any person, who, without lawful reason or excuse, whereof the burden of proof shall lie upon him, shall be found in or upon any prescribed area shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding S. 400 or to imprisonment of either description for a term not exceeding 3 months.

Cattle found in prescribed area to be forfeited.

(2) Any cattle found in any prescribed area, and any crops planted or buildings erected within such area without the prior sanction of some officer duly authorised in that behalf may be seized and forfeited to the Government and may be disposed of in such manner as may be directed by any Magistrate having jurisdiction within such area.

9. Offences against the provisions of this Ordinance shall be cognisable to the Police.

Power to make Rules.

10. The Governor-in-Council shall have power to make Rules from time to time for the better carrying out of the provisions of this Ordinance.

Saving the provisions of Section 151 of the Crown Lands Ordinance, 1915.

11. Nothing in this Ordinance shall be deemed to affect the provisions of section 151 of the Crown Lands Ordinance, 1915.

Repeal.

12. The Trespass Ordinance, 1913, and the Trespass Amendment Ordinance, 1914, are hereby repealed.

THE EAST AFRICA TOWNSHIPS ORDINANCE, 1903.

RULES.

"The Chairman of the Committee shall be such member thereof as the Governor shall appoint.
