THE MASTER AND SERVANTS
ORDINANCES, 1910 AND 1919.

RULES.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on him by the Master and Servants Ordinances, 1910 and 1919, His Excellency the Acting Governor-in-Council has been pleased to make the following Rules:—

1. These Rules may be cited as "The Master and Servants (Medical Inspection) Rules, 1923."

2. Where any servant is, in the opinion of a Government Medical Officer, physically unfit for any work which such servant may be required to perform, such Government Medical Officer may order the employer of such servant to return such servant to his place of engagement or to send him to a Native Hospital.

3. In any such case such employer shall, at the earliest opportunity and at his own expense, send such servant to his place of engagement or to a Native Hospital as ordered by such Government Medical Officer.

4. Any such employer who shall fail to comply with the provisions of the last preceding rule shall, on conviction by a Magistrate entitled to hold a Subordinate Court of the First or Second Class, be liable to a fine of ten pounds or to imprisonment of either description for a period not exceeding one month or to both such fine and imprisonment.
