## THE EAST AFRICA TOWNSHIPS ORDINANCE, 1903.

## TOWNSHIP OF MACHAKOS.

*Rules.*

IN EXERCISE of the powers so conferred by the East Africa Townships Ordinance, 1903, Section 3, and by the General Revision Ordinance, 1924, Section 27, the Governor's Deputy-in-Council has been pleased to make the following Rules:—

1. These Rules may be cited as "The Machakos Township (Dogs) Rules, 1924," and shall be read as one with the Rules, dated the 27th day of May, 1911, and all Rules in amendment thereof, applicable to the Township of Machakos.

2. In these Rules the word "Township" shall mean the Machakos Township.

3. No person shall keep a dog within the limits of the Township unless such person or the owner of the dog has registered the same at the office of the District Commissioner and is the holder of a certificate of registration granted in respect of such dog.

A fee of Shs. 10/- shall be charged for a certificate of registration and such certificate shall expire on the 31st day of December of the year in which it is granted. Provided that valid certificate of registration duly granted in any other Township shall authorise the holder thereof to keep the dog, in respect of which the certificate has been granted, in the Township of Machakos till the aforesaid date without further registration.

4. Every dog kept within the Township shall be provided with a collar inscribed with the name of the owner.

5. Rules 3 and 4 hereof shall not apply to dogs under 5 months of age.

6. The District Commissioner may cause all dogs found within the Township without collars, or dogs that he has reason to believe are ownerless, savage, or dangerous, to be seized and may deal with them as follows:—

(a) If the dog is diseased it shall be forthwith slaughtered;

(b) In any other case it may be destroyed, detained, kept, or otherwise dealt with as the District Commissioner may think fit, provided that when the dog bears a collar it shall be kept for three clear days and the owner notified, if possible, to give him an opportunity of claiming it.

## THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS ORDINANCE, 1922.

## BYE-LAWS.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon them by the Municipal Corporations Ordinance, 1922, the Municipal Council of Nairobi, with the approval of the Governor's Deputy-in-Council have made the following Bye-laws:—

1. These Bye-laws may be cited as "Nairobi (City Park) Bye-laws, 1924."

2. Nairobi (Municipal Forest) Bye-laws, 1922, are hereby amended by substituting for the words "Municipal Forest" and "Municipal Forest Reserve" wherever they occur the words "City Park;" and by adding thereto the following Bye-law:—

"No freight cart drawn by oxen, or mules shall go within the City Park unless by authority of the Municipal Council.

The owner and person or persons in charge of any such cart going within the City Park shall each severally be guilty of an offence."

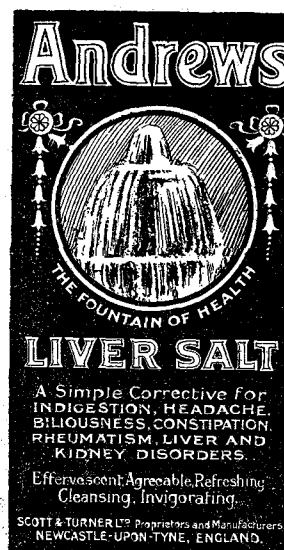

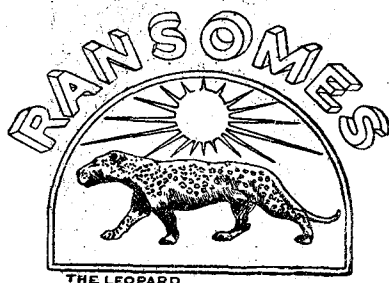
