Intituled

An Ordinance further to Amend the Law Relating to the Sale of Wines, Spirits and Malt Liquors.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Liquor (Amend. Short title. ment) Ordinance, 1924," and shall be read as one with the Liquor Ordinance, 1909, hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Ordinance," and all amendments thereto.

- 2. Section 9 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following sub-section:—
 - (14) Railway Restaurant Car Liquor Licence.
- 3. Section 10 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended Amendment by the addition thereto of the following sub-section:—

- (14) (a) A "Railway Restaurant Car Liquor Licence" shall Principal authorise the holder to sell any liquor on a Railway Restaurant Ordinance. Car.
 - (b) Such licence shall be necessary in respect of each Restaurant Car.
- (c) No liquor shall be sold under such licence except to 15 passengers travelling by the train to which such Restaurant Car is attached.
 - 4. The second Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following item:—

5. (1) For the purposes of Sub-section 24 (1) of the Principal Ordinance, as amended by Section 9 of the Liquor (Amendment) for and Ordinance, 1923, application for a Railway Restaurant Car Liquor granting of 25 Licence shall be made to the Resident Commissioner, Nairobi.

(2) For the purposes of Sub-section 11 (1) of the Principal Ordinance, as repealed and substituted by Section 7 of the Liquor (Amendment) Ordinance, 1923, the Court shall mean the Court for the Licensing Area within which Nairobi is situate.
