## A Bill

#### Intituled

## An Ordinance to Amend the Estate Duty Ordinance, 1918.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Estate Duty Short Title. (Amendment) Ordinance, 1924," and shall be read as one with "The Estate Duty Ordinance, 1918," hereinafter called "the Principal Ordinance" and with all amendments thereof.

2. Sub-section (2) of Section 12 of the Principal Ordinance Section 12 (2) of the Principal Ordinance is amended by the insertion of the word "not" after the words of the Pring Ordinance. "under a disposition" in the third line of the sub-section.

3. Sub-section (2) of Section 12 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby further amended by deleting the words "twelve months" and substituting therefor the words "three years."

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Registration of Short Title. Business Names (Amendment) Ordinance, 1924," and shall be read as one with "The Registration of Business Names Ordinance, 1918" (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Ordinance") and 5 all amendments thereof.

2. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following clauses:

"(i) Where the registration to be effected is that of a firm, the age of each partner thereof under the age of 21

"(j) Where the registration to be effected is that of an individual, the age of such individual if under the age of

Provided that where any such partner or individual is of or over the age of 21 years it shall be sufficient for him to state his age as 'full age' ".
