## RESIDENT NATIVE LABOURERS' ORDINANCE, 1925.

## RULES.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on him by the Resident Native Labourers' Ordinance, 1925, His Excellency the Acting Governor in Council has been pleased to make the following rules :—

1. These Rules may be cited as " The Resident Native Labourers (Registers) Rules, 1925."

2. The Registers required to be kept by an occupier under Sections 7 and 8 of the Resident Native Labourers Ordinance, 1925, shall be in the form set out in the Schedule hereto and shall be respectively referred to as the " Register of Natives " and the " Register of Stock."

3. When a contract has been entered into under Section 4 of the Resident Native Labourers Ordinance, 1925, the employer shall, at the conclusion of each day on which the person employed has worked thereunder, enter or cause to be entered in writing the letter " W " in the Register of Natives against the name of and in the column corresponding to the date on which the person employed has so worked. The amounts paid to each native and the date of payment shall be entered in the proper column.

4. Every occupier shall forthwith enter or cause to be entered in writing in the Register of Stock the particulars of stock belonging to natives lawfully residing on his farm, which may from time to time be brought to or born on or removed from or die on such farm. Any increase or decrease of such stock shall be shown as a resultant total or balance as the case may be, and shall be dated accordingly in the columns provided for those purposes in the said Register.

5. When a native may no longer lawfully reside on a farm under Section 3 of the Resident Native Labourers Ordinance, 1925, the occupier of such farm shall forthwith enter or cause to be entered in writing the reason thereof in the Remarks Column of the Register of Natives, and in the Register of Stock. All such entries shall be dated accordingly.

## THE EAST AFRICA TOWNSHIPS ORDINANCE, 1903.

## RULES.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon him by the East Africa Townships Ordinance, 1903, and all other powers thereunto enabling him, His Excellency the Acting Governor in Council has been pleased to make the following Rules :—

THE EAST AFRICA TOWNSHIPS ORDINANCE, 1903.  
TOWNSHIP OF NAIVASHA.

## RULES.

IN EXERCISE of the powers so conferred by the East Africa Townships Ordinance, 1903, Section 3, and by the General Revision Ordinance, 1924, Section 27, His Excellency the Acting Governor in Council has been pleased to make the following rules :—

1. These Rules may be cited as " The Naivasha Township Rules, 1925," and shall be read as one with the Rules dated the 23rd day of August, 1910, hereafter referred to as " The Principal Rules, and all Rules in amendment thereof applicable to the Township of Naivasha.

2. Rule 34 of the Principal Rules is hereby cancelled, and the following substituted therefor :—

" (a) No person shall keep, or graze, cattle, horses, mules, donkeys, sheep, goats or pigs within the Township except under a permit from the District Commissioner.

" Any person committing a breach of this rule shall be liable on conviction to pay a fine not exceeding Shs. 100/-, or in default to imprisonment of either kind not exceeding fourteen days.

" The fees mentioned in the First Schedule shall be paid for each permit.

" (b) Any person herding such stock and being unable on demand to produce such permit shall be liable to a fine not exceeding Shs. 2/-."

3. Schedule I of the Principal Rules is hereby amended by the cancellation of the fees set out under the heading " Permit to keep cattle, etc.," and the substitution of the following :—

Permit to keep cattle, horses, mules, donkeys, maximum not to exceed 20 head—50 cents per head per mensem or part thereof.

Permit to keep sheep and goats—12 cents per head per mensem or part thereof.

Permit to keep pigs—24 cents per head per mensem or part thereof.

4. These Rules shall be applicable only to the Township of Naivasha.

## THE PRISONS ORDINANCE, 1914.

## RULES.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon him by Section 116 of the Prisons Ordinance, 1914, His Excellency the Acting Governor in Council has been pleased to make the following rules :—

*Censorship of Prisoners' Letters.*

1. Every letter to or from a prisoner shall be read by the Superintendent of the Prison, and, if the contents are considered objectionable, it shall not be forwarded, or the objectionable part erased, according to discretion.
2. Letters from prisoners intended for the press will not be forwarded.
3. When it is found necessary to withhold an outward-going letter from a prisoner on account of objectionable matter therein, he may be given an opportunity of rewriting it, omitting the objectionable matter.
4. An inward-coming letter addressed to a prisoner containing matter which is considered objectionable shall be returned to the writer with an intimation that the letter must be re-submitted with the objectionable matter omitted before it will be delivered to the prisoner to whom it is addressed.
5. The Superintendent of a Prison shall keep a register of letters to and from prisoners, in which shall be noted any action taken as regards withholding letters or return of letters to the writer for alteration or to be rewritten.

10. Residence of employees on the area selected will be sanctioned, if approved by the Medical Officer of Health.

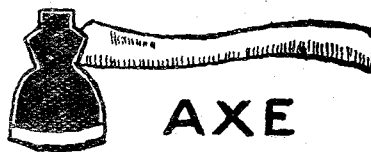

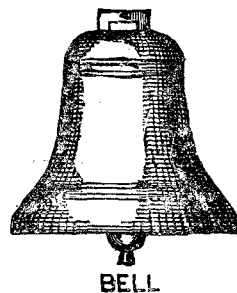
