HIS Excellency the Acting Governor regrets to announce the death of Dr. Bernard William Dakers, L.R.C.P., L.R.C.S., Edin., L.F.P.S., Glasg., at Kisumu, on July 16th, 1925. Dr. Dakers entered the service of this Colony on 25th June, 1920, and was employed throughout in Native Reserves where, by his tact and sympathy, he gained the confidence of the local population and was instrumental in popularizing European methods of treatment. He was the first Medical Officer to be stationed in South Kavirondo and his work in that district in connection with yaws was specially noteworthy.

WITH a view to examining the possibilities of establishing an industry for the manufacture of salt locally, tenders are invited for the right to exploit and manufacture salt from sea water.

Plots of from 5 to 10 acres may be selected by the tenderers in the following areas:—

- (a) The Mombasa Island Creek.
- (b) Gongoni.
- (c) Lamu.

Tenders should be in the form of annual rent and the successful tenderer will be granted a licence of the area selected under the following conditions:—

1. Term 1 year from the 1st July, 1925, terminable then or at any time thereafter by 3 months notice.

2. The area to be used exclusively for the manufacture, storage and sale of salt manufactured thereon and for works and purposes connected therewith.

3. Operations over the area to be commenced within 3 months of the commencement of the term of the licence.

4. Salt pans to be at least 100 yards apart.

5. The quality of the salt manufactured and sold, to be to the satisfaction of the Medical Officer of Health.

6. The licensee to take actual and effective steps continually to prevent the breeding of mosquitos on or near to the area.

7. Natives in the locality to have the free right to take away for their own use any brine or salt in its natural state without let or hindrance.

8. The licensee will be required to respect the rights of the public over the foreshore and to indemnify Government against all actions, claims, demands and expenses in respect of any injury or infringement of any public or private rights over the foreshore and occasioned by the exercise of the liberties and powers granted under the licence.

9. Government will not be responsible for an adverse effect caused by any constructional works which may be undertaken in the vicinity of the area selected.

10. Residence of employees on the area selected will be sanctioned, if approved by the Medical Officer of Health.

Sealed tenders marked “Salt Concession” should be deposited with the Commissioner of Lands at the Land Department, Nairobi, before noon on the 31st August, 1925.
