GOVERNMENT NOTICE NO 16

THE FOREST ORDINANCE

RULES

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon him by sections 13 and 14 of the Forest Ordinance (Chapter 149 of the Revised Edition), His Excellency the Governor in Council has been pleased to make the following Rules —

1 These Rules may be cited as “the Forest Rules (Meru), 1927”

2 These Rules shall apply to the areas situated in the Meru Native Reserve named Thua, Oingu, Nyambeni and Ngaia and demarcated by a cut and beacons line

3 No person shall fell, cut, take, work, burn, injure, or remove any trees, other than dead and fallen trees, growing within the areas named above without having first obtained a licence in that behalf from the District Commissioner in the form set out in the Schedule hereto

4 No licence shall be issued for the cutting of trees of less than 20ins diameter at breast height (4ft 3ins from the ground) of the following species —

Provided that the provisions of this Rule shall not apply to dead wood

5 There shall be paid by the holder of a licence granted pursuant to Rule 3, royalties at the following rates —

(1) not more than 2 inches in diameter at breast height (4ft 3ins) 8 poles	1	00
(2) not more than 4 inches in diameter at breast height, 6 poles	1	00
(3) not more than 6 inches in diameter at breast height, 4 poles	1	00
(4) not more than 8 inches in diameter at breast height, 2 poles	1	00
(5) trees in excess of 8 inches in diameter at the rates prescribed by rules under the said Forest Ordinance		

6 No huts shall be erected, fires lighted, grazing done or cultivation carried out without the permission in writing of the District Commissioner

7 Any person affected by these Rules who shall refuse, neglect or fail to comply therewith shall be guilty of an offence and shall on conviction before a magistrate or before a Native Tribunal having jurisdiction over such native be liable to a fine not exceeding one hundred and fifty shillings and in default of payment to imprisonment of either description for a term not exceeding two months

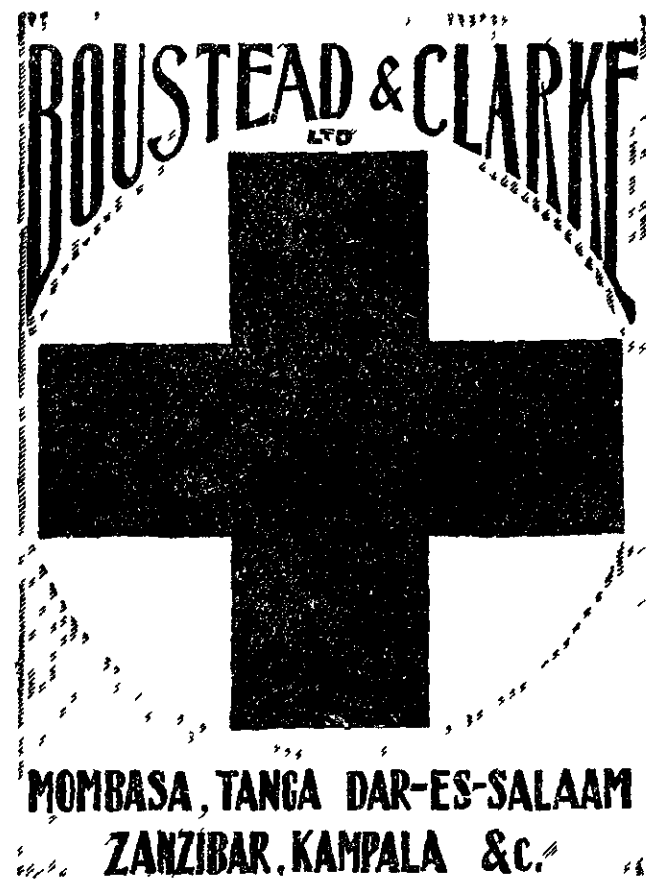

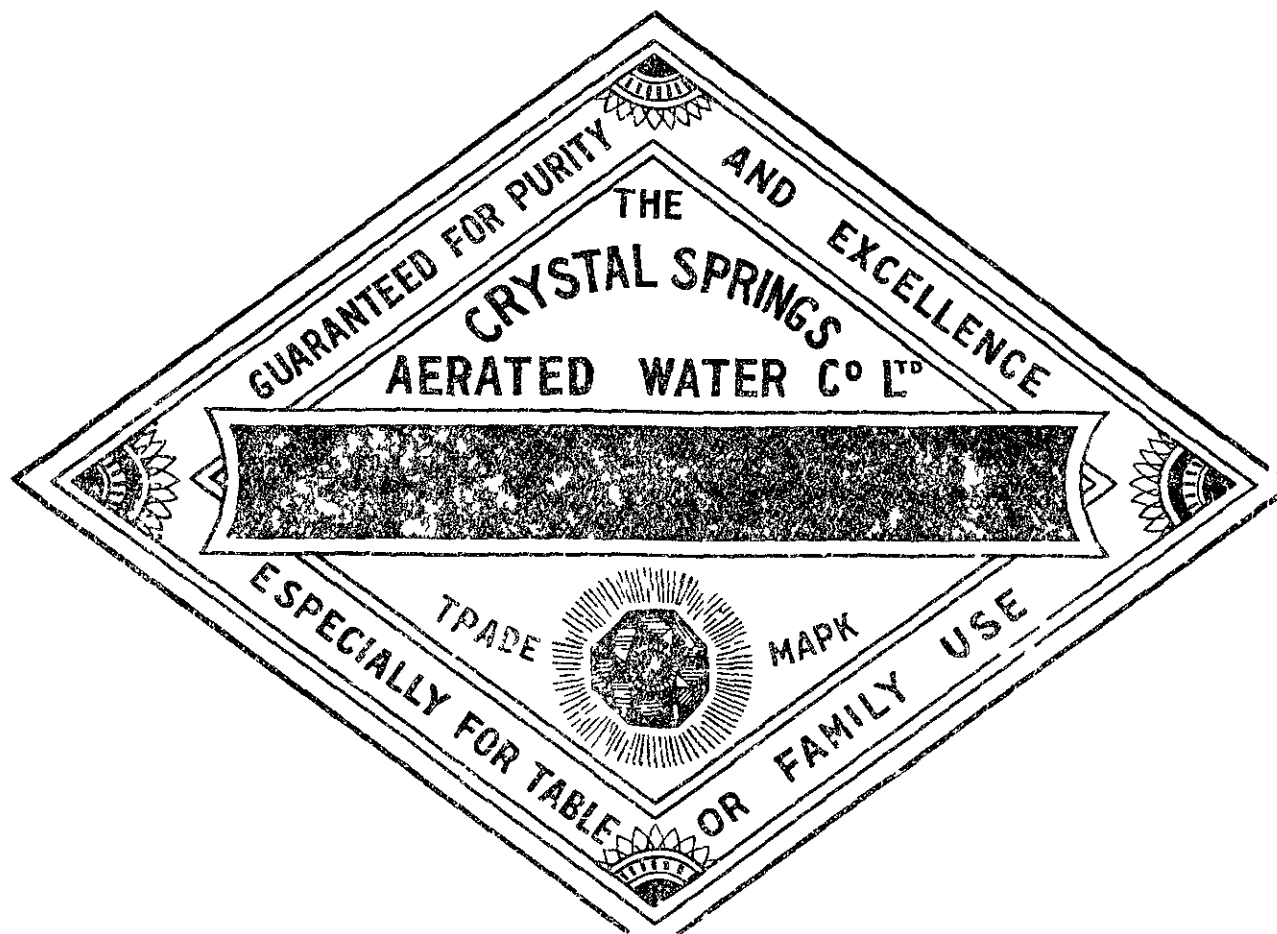
